### I Am Meant to Know God 1 year olds - 4 year olds

#### Leader Notes

**Bible Passage:** God Created the World- Genesis 1-2, Psalm 8

**Bottom Line:** We can know God through His World

**Leader Context:** We are meant to know God. One way God shows us Himself is through His world. We get to help kids know that God created everything- including them- and He has a great purpose in everything He creates.

**THE WIN FOR SUNDAY GROUPS:** Give kids a first look at The Bible, Jesus, and our need for a Savior by embracing their physical needs or engaging their interests. Use The Code when necessary to help redirect kids and build relationships.

#### Games and Music (10 minutes)

**What You Need:** Feb 4 Social Instruction Page, Game Sets, Roku Game Instructions, I spy printable (1 per kid) magnifying glasses, butcher paper with planets and stars and moons drawn on it, crayons, star stickers

#### What You Do:

- Play worship songs and other songs available on Roku during the Social Game or while kids are playing.
- Using the supplies and game instruction page, choose one game to play with the kids today.
- As you are playing, use this as a time to call each kid by name and learn their names well.

**Say:** That was a fun game to get us ready to watch our Bible video. Let's sit and listen to our story today."

#### Bible Story Video (10 minutes)

#### Bible Story Recap- Say This!

Thanks, Super Crew! Today's Super clue is a leaf. What is it? (A leaf!) (Do the hand motion of a leaf falling to the ground.) The Super Crew discovered that God made leaves and everything in world. God shows us Himself through His world. God is our Creator. That means He made the whole world and everything in it. And do you know what else? When we look at the world God made, it helps us know more about God! God made everything, and He loves us so much. Let's thank God for the world He made as we pray. Praying is talking and listening to God. Let's be still, close our eyes, and pray 3-2-1.

God, thank You for making the world. Help us learn more about You when we look at the world around us. Amen."

Can you say the Big Deal with me?

I Spy! (*point to eyes*)

God wants me! (*Move hands to chest*)

To Know Him! (*point to sky*)

Let's do that a few more times.

#### Videos

**Catch a Shooting Star (20 minutes)**

**What You Need:** Shooting star printable ( 1 per kid, on cardstock), paint sticks, crayons

**Say:**

Has anyone ever seen a shooting star? It can be hard to spot a shooting star, but if you see one, it's really cool. Let's make our own shooting stars to help remind us that God made the sky. I want each of you to color one of these stars. Then you are going to take the paint stick and make trails for your stars.

**Say :** "In today's Bible story, we learned about how God made the skhy. Think about how big the sky is. There are so many stars, we can't even count all of them. God made all of them! Our God is so big! You made beautiful artwork today. Isn't it awesome that the God who created everything wants us to know Him? We can talk to God and thank Him for making all of the amazing things we see."

**Say:**

- What was our Super Clue today? (a leaf) What does it help us remember?(*God shows us Himself through His world. God made everything, and God cares about everything He made- including you and me!*)
- What was your favorite part of the Bible story?
- We can know God through His world. He made the whole world and cares about everything He made- especially us! When we look at all the things God made it reminds us of Him and HIs great big love for us. Will you name some things God made?
- What is something you learned about God today?
- What can you tell your friends and families about this week?

Our Big Deal is, "I Spy! God wants me to Know Him"

I Spy(*Point to eyes.*)

God wants me (*Move hands to chest*)

to Know Him( *Point to sky*)

God wants us to know Him. As we look around the world God made, we can know Him more. Even when we see something as simple as a leaf, we can remember that God cares about the tiny details, like the shape of a leaf, and He cares about the little things in our lives too. God made everything, including us, and He loves us very much."

**Prepare kids to talk with their family about what they learned today.**

- Pass out coloring pages for kids to take home.
- As family members arrive to pick up their kid, greet them and tell them one thing you noticed about their kid that day or something you talked to each kid about remembering this week.
- If there is time to chat with the family, ask how you can pray for them this week.
- Say bye to the kids and call them by name.
