## **February 2** **I Am Loved**

**1 year olds - 4 year olds**

**Leader Notes**

**Bible Passage:** God Loved Adam and Eve- Genesis 2-3

**Bottom Line:** God Loved First

**Leader Context:** God's loved us first, and His love is best, bigger than anything, and goes on forever. (Read Genesis 3:22-23.) In His love, God sent Adam and Eve out of the garden so they would not eat from the tree of life and live forever in their broken state. It was part of the consequence of their sin, but it was also the most loving thing He could do for them. God made away for them to be reconciled through Jesus. This week, we are teaching kids that, even though there is punishment for their sin, God showed incredible love. We get to teach kids that we can never earn or deserve love because God loved us first.

**THE WIN FOR SUNDAY GROUPS:** Give kids a first look at The Bible, Jesus, and our need for a Savior by embracing their physical needs or engaging their interests. Use The Code when necessary to help redirect kids and build relationships.

### **Games and Music (10 minutes)**

**What You Need:** Social Instruction Page, Game Sets, Roku Game Instructions, Bark Coloring Page (Several) crayons, Toy food (several), Toy kitchen items (several), Red and green construction paper (several), Scissors (1 per group; adult-use only) (Cut pieces of red and green construction paper into fourths. Each preschooler should have one red piece of paper and one green piece of paper. )

**What You Do:**

- Play worship songs and other songs available on Roku during the Social Game or while kids are playing.
- Using the supplies and game instruction page, choose one game to play with the kids today.
- As you are playing, use this as a time to call each kid by name and learn their names well.

**Say:** That was a fun game to get us ready to watch our Bible video. Let's sit and listen to our story today."

### **Bible Story Video (10 minutes)**

#### **Bible Story Recap- Say This!**

Thanks, Super Crew! In today's Bible story we learned that God made the first people—Adam and Eve. God loved them very much. Even when Adam and Eve made a wrong choice, God still loved them.

God loved us first. Even before we were born, God knew we would make wrong choices too. He showed His deep and wide love for us by sending Jesus for us before we were even born.

Our Super Clue is a first-place medal. The number one on our medal stands for first place.

God loved first, from the very beginning. Let's say, "God loved first," together. Ready? "God loved first." Good job! God loved Adam and Eve, and God loves you and me. His love is deep and wide because He loved first.

Let's take a moment to pray. When we pray, we are talking and listening to God. When we pray, we don't want to be distracted, so let's close our eyes and pray in 3-2-1.

*God, thank You for loving us first, before we were even born. Thank You for our friends in the room and for loving each of them. Amen.*

Can you say the Big Deal with me?

Deep and Wide! (Move hands facing each other, expand out vertically, and rotate horizontally.)

God Loves Me! (Cross arms over chest.)

Let's do that a few more times.

**Make A Medal — 20 Minutes**

Preschoolers will make a medal to remind them of the Super Clue.

**Leader Prep:** Cut pieces of ribbon two feet long, one per child. Hole punch one hole in the top of each yellow circle, one per child. Set out supplies.

**Supplies:** 2 inch yellow circle cutouts (1 per child), Yellow Ribbon (several), Handheld hole punch (1 per group; adult-use only), Scissors (1 per group; adult-use only), Markers or crayons (several), Number 1 Stickers (2 per kid- print on 1 inch round label)

**Craft Instructions:**

1. Before the session, cut pieces of ribbon two feet long, one per child. Hole punch one hole in the top of each yellow circle, one per child.
2. Give each child a yellow circle cutout, Number 1 sticker (2 per kid) markers or crayons, and a piece of ribbon.
3. Assist preschoolers in placing a “1” on the center of the each side of the circle cutout..
4. Invite preschoolers to decorate their medals.
5. Assist preschoolers in threading a piece of ribbon through the hole and tying a knot at the end of the medal pieces to create a medal for preschoolers to wear.

**What To Do:** Can anyone remember what our Super Clue is today? (*Allow responses.*) That’s right! It is a first-place medal. Today we are going to make our own first-place medals so you can remember the Super Clue. I want each of you to take a yellow circle and 2 number 1 stickers. You are going to place a sticker on each side of your circle cutout. Decorate your medal with fun colors. I can’t wait to see what you create. A leader will come around to help you thread ribbon in your medal so that you can wear it.

**Loud And Clear:** Let’s see your awesome medals. These are terrific! Let’s put our medals on. Ready? (*Put medals on.*) God loves each one of you. God showed His amazing love to Adam and Eve. Even though they made a wrong choice, God still loved them. We all make wrong choices, but God still loves us! **God loved first.**

**Say:**

- Who remembers what our Super Clue is today? (*a first-place medal*)
- Today’s Super Clue is a first-place medal. What does a first-place medal help us remember? (*God loved first.*)
- God loved first. What do you think it means when you hear that God loved first? (*God loved me before I was born. His love is the best.*)
- What did you learn about God today?
- What can you tell your family about God’s love for you?
- Who can you tell about what you learned today?

Our Big Deal is, “Deep and Wide, God Loves Me!”

Deep and Wide! (*Move hands facing each other, expand out vertically, and rotate horizontally.*)

God Loves Me! (*Cross arms over chest.*)

God made Adam and Eve and loved them very much, even when they did not make a right choice. God loves us the same. God’s love is deep and wide. That reminds me of our Big Deal. Let’s say it together one more time. “Deep and Wide! God Loves Me!”

**Going Home**

**Prepare kids to talk with their family about what they learned today.**

- Pass out coloring pages for kids to take home.
- Say bye to the kids and call them by name.
