Leader Notes

Bible Passage: Jesus Calmed the Storm- Mark 4:35-41

Bottom Line: God controls the world.

Leader Context: Jesus controlled the wind and the waves when He was on the sea with the disciples. This story reminds us that God controls the entire world. Even the wind and the waves.

THE WIN FOR SUNDAY GROUPS: Give kids a first look at The Bible, Jesus, and our need for a Savior by embracing their physical needs or engaging their interests. Use The Code when necessary to help redirect kids and build relationships.

Games and Music (10 minutes)

What You Need: Instruction Page, Game Sets, Roku Game Instructions

What You Do:

- Play worship songs and other songs available on Roku during the Social Game or while kids are playing.
- Using the supplies and game instruction page, choose one game to play with the kids today.
- As you are playing, use this as a time to call each kid by name and learn their names well.

Say: That was a fun game to get us ready to watch our Bible video. Let's sit and listen to our story today."

Bible Story Video (10 minutes)

Bible Story Recap- Say This!

Bye, Super Crew! Wow! I am so thankful God controls our world. God is strong and mighty! He controls everything in the world around us. God is in charge of our world because He created it. I am so thankful that we have a God who is strong and mighty. God controls our world, and He takes care of you and me.

Let's pray and talk to God together. When we pray we close our eyes so we can focus and pay attention while talking to God. Let's pray right now and thank God for being in control of the whole world.. Let's pray in 3-2-1.

God thank You for creating the world around us. You are strong and mighty, and You are in control of everything. Thank You for being with us and taking care of us. Amen."

Can you say the Big Deal with me?

Strong and Mighty! (*make muscles*)

God takes care of me! (*Cross arms and hug yourself*)

Let's do that a few more times. Who is strong and mighty? Who takes care of you?

Make Faces Craft (20 minutes)

What You Need: Make faces printable (1 per kid). craft sticks, tape or glue, crayons or markers (several)

Say:

Today we are learning that God can help us be strong and mighty when we are afraid. Let's follow these instructions as we make our craft.

- First color the faces on your paper.
- Second, fold the paper in half.
- Third, tape a craft stick to the inside of the folded paper, leaving part of it out to use as a handle.
- Fourth, glue the inside pages together.
- Now let's use the signs we just made to play a game. I will share a few different situations. I want you to respond by holding up the happy face if it's something that makes you happy or the scared face if it's something that you think is scary.

Use these or create your own.

Your mom asks you to eat a plate of broccoli.

You are about to go down a big slide at the playground.

You are going to sleep but your night light isn't turned on.

You have to go to the doctor.

You see a snake A spider. A fluffy puppy..

Say : "God is strong and mighty. He is in charge of everything. Whether we are happy or scared, we can always trust God to take care of us. When we are afraid, He helps us be strong and mighty too."

Say:

- What was our Super Clue today? (*a globe*) What does it help us remember? (*God controls the world*)
- What was your favorite part of the Bible story?
- God controls the world. He controls the wind, the rain, the water, and the air. What did Jesus calm today in the Bible story? (*wind and waves in a storm.*)
- What is something you learned about God today?
- What can you tell your friends and families about this week?

Our Big Deal is, "Strong and Mighty! God takes care of me"

Strong and Mighty(*Flex arm muscles.*)

God takes care of me(*Cross arms and hug yourself*)

Because God made the world, He controls the world. When we say God is in control, we mean God is in charge of everything He made, even things like wind and waves. He is strong and mighty, and we can see how awesome He is when we look the world around us. God takes care of His world and He takes care of each of us too!"

Prepare kids to talk with their family about what they learned today.

- Pass out coloring pages for kids to take home.
- As family members arrive to pick up their kid, greet them and tell them one thing you noticed about their kid that day or something you talked to each kid about remembering this week.
- If there is time to chat with the family, ask how you can pray for them this week.
- Say bye to the kids and call them by name.
