SOCIAL TIME

The first 10-15 minutes as kid's arrive are some of our most important times to meet needs and show kids they are valued. This is why we provide strategic activities for you help engage with every kid as they arrive.

- This month you have Hot Potato and Scavenger Hunt or Memory Game.
- You will also find 2 Social activities each week. ***Use one now and one at the end to redirect attention.*

Games and Music (10 minutes)

What You Need: Social Game Instruction Page including Roku Games, Pool Noodles (10 per group), Flame Poster (1 per group), Bark Color Pages, Crayons

What You Do:

- Play worship songs and other songs available on Roku during the Social Game or while kids are playing.
- Using the supplies and game instruction page, choose one game to play with the kids today.
- As you are playing, use this as a time to call each kid by name and learn their names well.

Say: That was a fun game to get us ready to watch our Bible video. Let's sit and listen to our story today."

Bible Story - Say This!

Thanks, Super Crew! Wow! We need God every day. In our Bible story, God's people, the Israelites (IZ ray el ights), needed God every day to help them through hard and difficult times. God loved His people and cared for them, and God cares for us when we hurt too. God cares when our bodies hurt, like if we scrape our knees or bump our heads. God also cares when we feel sad, mad, lonely, or afraid. God cares about us anytime we hurt. Our Super Clue today is a crayon. A crayon can be used every day to draw, and color. It reminds us that we need God every day and that God cares about us.

Let's talk and listen to God. This is called prayer. Ready? Let's pray in 3-2-1.

God, thank You for today and the reminder that You are with us every day. We need You every day. Thank You for loving us and caring for us when we hurt. In Jesus' name, amen.

Can you say the Big Deal with me?

Help Is on the Way! (*Bring hands to mouth like you are yelling.*)

God Cares When I Hurt! (*Give yourself a hug.*)

Bible Story Video (10 minutes)**Super Clue Stretch- Craft (20 minutes)**

Big Goal: Remember what is super about the Super Clue.

Leader Prep: Print "Super Clue Stretch" printables, one per child, and pre-fold at the dotted lines.

Supplies: "Super Clue Stretch" printable (1 per child), Crayons (several)

Craft Instructions:

1. Before the session, print "Super Clue Stretch" printables, front and back, one per child, and pre-fold at the dotted lines.
2. Give each child a "Super Clue Stretch" printable.
3. Instruct preschoolers to use crayons to color and decorate their pages.
4. Show them how to unfold and open their pictures to see how they stretch out to be larger crayons. Read the words on the crayon.

What To Do: Our Super Clue today is a crayon. What is our Super Clue? (A crayon!) That's right! We can use crayons every day to have fun while coloring pictures. I want you to use crayons, our Super Clue, to decorate your crayon printable. (Show crayon printable and open the folds to reveal the words.) You can decorate your picture with your favorite colors. A crayon reminds us we need God's help every day.

Leader Tip: Talk with preschoolers while they are decorating their pictures. Reinforce the connection with the Super Clue.

Loud And Clear: I love seeing everyone's stretching Super Clues. They are such fun reminders that God cares for us and that we need God's help every day. God cares for us in big ways and small ways. God cares for us all of the time, and He even cares when we hurt! The next time you see a crayon you can remember that we need God and that He cares for us every day.

Say:

- Who remembers what our Super Clue is today? *(a crayon)*
- What does a crayon help us remember? *(We can use crayons every day to draw and color. A crayon helps us remember that God is with us every day. God takes care of us every day. We need His care every day.)*
- What was something you liked about Large Group?
- **I need God every day.** What is one way you need God's help every day?
- What did you learn about God today?
- Do you remember today's Big Deal? Repeat after me *(with motions below)*:
Help Is on the Way! *(Help Is on the Way!)* God Cares When I Hurt! *(God Cares When I Hurt!)*

Keep It Going: Form two teams of preschoolers. Assign the first part of the Big Deal to one team: "Help Is on the Way!" Assign the second part of the Big Deal to the other team: "God Cares When I Hurt!" Point to each team and invite them to say their part of the Big Deal.

Big Deal Motions:

Help Is on the Way! *(Bring hands to mouth like you are yelling.)*

God Cares When I Hurt! *(Give yourself a hug.)*

We need God every day. In today's Bible story, God helped His people face hard and scary things. God guided them and provided food and water for them. Like the Israelites, we need God to help us and take care of us.

Prepare kids to talk with their family about what they learned today.

- Pass out coloring pages for kids to take home.
- As family members arrive to pick up their kid, greet them and tell them one thing you noticed about their kid that day or something you talked to each kid about remembering this week.
- If there is time to chat with the family, ask how you can pray for them this week.
- Say bye to the kids and call them by name.
