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Opening

MEDIA SLIDE: Intro Slide

10 minutes- Glo Hunt Game

MEDIA SLIDE: Glo Hunt Slide, Glo Hunt Instructions

Supplies: Glo Hunt pictures set (1 set per group), Glo Hunt Card Set (1 set per group), bucket (1 per group)

Game Setup: Tape the Glo Hunt pictures to the walls, ensuring they are not too high for kids to reach. Place Glo Hunt Cards in the buckets. Divide the group into 2 teams.

What to Do:

- Invite a kid to draw a card from the bucket and read it.
- The first player on each team will race to find the picture and bring back to their team.
- Players will take turns until all the cards and pictures are returned.
- The winner is the team with the most pictures.

HOST: Welcome, everyone! My name is ____ and I am so glad you're here—it is *glo*-time!

Turn to a few people around you, tell them your name, give them a high five, and say, "Let's glo!"
(Allow time.)

Alright, I love that energy!

Tonight is going to be packed with some seriously *neon fun*. We've got games, chances for some of you to come up front and compete, videos to watch, and time to talk it out with your group. But here's the big idea for tonight—everything we're doing is about *light*.

We're learning how to bring things into the light and understand what that means for our lives and our families.

So let's start here—when you think about light or things that glow, what comes to your mind?

Turn to your small group and share your ideas. Ready... go!

(Allow time.)

Alright, I'm hearing some great answers!



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Video

Now let's get ready for our next part. Eyes up front—it's time to watch a video together.

MEDIA SLIDE: Intro

VIDEO (5 minutes)

HOST: Alright, friends, we're about to watch a video that shows us what happened after Jesus went back to heaven. But don't just sit back and watch—let's be detectives!

As you watch, I want you to keep your eyes open for anything that looks like light... anything glowing... anything shining.

When you see it, don't shout it out—just remember it and hold onto it.

After the video, your small group leader is going to help you talk about what you noticed and why it matters.

Alright, eyes up, minds ready... let's watch!

PLAY: "God's Super Helper"

MEDIA SLIDE: Gods Super Helper_mp4

HOST: That was awesome. Did you catch any of those glowing or light moments?

In the video, we heard about a Super Helper that God sent. Jesus told His disciples that even though He was going back to heaven, they wouldn't be alone.

He sent the Holy Spirit.

The Holy Spirit helps us, guides us, and shows us what is right and wrong. And just like we saw light in the video, the Holy Spirit helps us see clearly and understand God.

Jesus even said He is the Light of the World.

Now it's your turn to talk about it.

Turn to your small group and spend a few minutes working through the questions on the screen. Your leader will help you get started.

Go ahead and move into groups!

DISCUSSION (5 minutes)

MEDIA SLIDE: Discussion Part 1

- What did you see in the video that glowed or had light around it or in it?
- What does seeing light or glowing things make you think of?
- How do you think light shows you something about God?



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GAME

5 minutes- Glo High Glo Low Game

HOST: We are going to play some games together as a group. We will also have some opportunities for players who are ready to "glo" up front and play in some friendly competition. Who's ready for a game called GLO HIGH, GLO LOW?

GAME- GLO HIGH, GLO LOW (5 minutes)

SUPPLIES: Glow bracelets (1 per person) Small group leaders will pass these out.

MEDIA SLIDE: LetsGlo_GloHighGloLow

Host: In this first game, you and your group will walk around the space, doing your best not to walk together. As soon as the music stops, you will see a prompt on the screen—Glo High or Glow Low. If it says "Glo High," you will hurry to find your group and hold your glow bracelets up high together. If it says "Glow Low," you will hurry to find your group and hold your glow bracelets down low together. Do you think your group can gather and glow the fastest? Everyone, stand up and let's see!

MEDIA VIDEO: LetsGlo_GloHighGloLow_Video1

Host: (Begin once the video ends.) Glo high! Find your group and hold your glow bracelets high! (Allow time.) Great job! Let's get moving again.

MEDIA VIDEO: LetsGlo_GloHighGloLow_Video2

Host: (Begin once the video ends.) Find your group and glo low! (Allow time.) Awesome. Start moving around again.

MEDIA VIDEO: LetsGlo_GloHighGloLow_Video3

Host: (Begin once the video ends.) Glo low again. Find your group fast! (Allow time.) This time when you start moving, move in any way other than walking. Ready? Glo!

MEDIA VIDEO: LetsGlo_GloHighGloLow_Video4

Host: (Begin once the video ends.) Find your group and glo high! (Allow time.) Awesome. Start moving around again.

MEDIA VIDEO: LetsGlo_GloHighGloLow_Video5

Host: (Begin once the video ends.) This time, bend low and glo high! Hurry! (Allow time.) We have one more round, so start moving while waving your arms in the air!

Host: (Begin once the video ends.) Stand high and glo low! That will take some real stretching! (Allow time.) **MEDIA SLIDE: LetsGlo_GloHighGloLow**

Great playing, everyone. You can go back to your seats.



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LESSON

HOST: (10 minutes)- Teaching MEDIA SLIDE: Intro

MEDIA SLIDE: Red Flag Signs

Alright friends, let's come back together.

We just talked about the Holy Spirit—God's helper—and how Jesus is the Light of the World. Light helps us see what's true. Light helps us know what's right.

And guess what? When we follow Jesus, His light helps *us* too.

Listen to this verse:

Ephesians 5:13 says, "Everything exposed by the light becomes visible—and everything that is illuminated becomes a light."

That means when something is brought into the light, we can see it clearly. Nothing has to stay hidden or confusing.

So here's a big idea for today:

When something feels off, we bring it into the light.

Sometimes in life, we feel things that don't seem right. Your heart might feel unsure. Your brain might go, "Wait... what is that?"

We call those red flags.

Say it with me: **Red flags. (echo)**

Red flags are anything that makes you feel confused, uncomfortable, or unsure.

And when a red flag goes off, we don't ignore it—we bring it into the light by talking to someone we trust.

Let's look at a couple of important red flags.

Red Flag #1

MEDIA SLIDE: Red Flag Signs (2)

If you hear a new word and you don't know what it means, and you start wondering about it...

That's a red flag.

Your brain is saying, "Hey, I need help understanding this."

So what do you do?

MEDIA SLIDE: Red Flag Signs (4)

You stop... and you talk to mom or dad.

Because bringing it into the light helps you understand what's true.



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LESSON

Red Flag #2

MEDIA SLIDE: Red Flag Sign (3)

If anyone ever asks you to keep a secret...

That is a BIG red flag.

Your brain should go, "Whoa—something's not right."

Now listen carefully, because this is important:

There is a difference between a surprise and a secret.

A surprise has an ending.

The gift will be given.

The party will happen.

Everyone will find out.

But a secret is meant to stay hidden forever.

And we don't keep secrets from our parents.

So if anyone says, "Don't tell your mom or dad..."

You don't keep that. You bring it into the light.

MEDIA SLIDE: Red Flag Sign (4)

You stop... and you tell your parents.

HOST (*lean in, more personal*):

MEDIA SLIDE: Red Flag Signs (5)

Listen—God gave you the Holy Spirit to help guide you.

That little feeling inside that says, "Something's not right"... that matters.

You are not meant to figure everything out on your own.

You are meant to bring things into the light.

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GAME & DISCUSS

MEDIA SLIDE: Red Flag Warning Slide

Alright, let's try something fun to practice this.

We're going to play a quick game.

In this game, we're going to look for red flags. Remember red flags are things you see, hear or find that you don't know or if someone asks you to keep a secret. When you see a red flag, we're going to shine a light on it—because we bring red flags into the light. Then we will hold up our hands and say "STOP!- Tell a trusted adult"

If it's not a red flag, don't shine your light.

So get ready—lights up! *(Kids will use their glow sticks as a light. Ask kids to hold their glow stick in the air when they see a red flag. Small group leaders will pass out the glow sticks.)*

Let's see how good you are at spotting red flags and bringing them into the light!

DISCUSSION: (5 minutes) MEDIA SLIDE: Discussion Part 2

- What is a red flag, and how does it help you know something isn't right?
- What should you do when a red flag goes off in your mind or heart? Who can you talk to?
- Why is it important to bring things into the light instead of keeping them a secret?

HOST:

Alright, that was awesome. You did a great job spotting red flags and bringing them into the light. And did you notice something? When we shine light on something, it becomes easier to see what's really there. We're about to play a game that shows us just how important light is.

MEDIA SLIDE: LetsGlo_GlointheDark



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GAME

Next up is "**Glo in the Dark,**" and this is for everyone!

We're going to watch a video with different animals—but here's the challenge... most of the screen will be dark. There will only be a small spotlight moving around, showing just a tiny part at a time. So you'll have to look closely!

As soon as you think you know the animal, stand up and make the sound of that animal.

GAME: GLO IN THE DARK (5 minutes)

SUPPLIES: None

MEDIA SLIDE: LetsGlo_GlointheDark

Host: Next up is "Glo in the Dark," and this is for everyone. We will watch a video featuring different animals. However, most of the video will be dark. There will be one small spotlight moving across the picture, revealing just a little bit. As soon as you can guess the animal, stand up and make the noise of that animal! Once the answer is revealed, give someone near you a glowing high five, then sit down to get ready for the next one. Will you be the first to guess correctly? If you are ready, say, "Glo in the Dark!" (Glo in the Dark!)

MEDIA VIDEO: LetsGlo_GlointheDark_Video

Host: (Begin once the video ends.) Great glo guessing! You can sit back down. Some of those were really tricky! A little more light could have made a big difference!

MEDIA SLIDE: LetsGlo_GlointheDark

HOST:

Alright, that was fun! Some of those animals were tough to figure out, weren't they? When it was dark, it was hard to tell what you were looking at... but when the light hit it—you could see clearly.



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REVIEW

HOST: MEDIA SLIDE: Intro Slide

Alright, that was fun! Some of those animals were tough to figure out, weren't they?

When it was dark, it was hard to tell what you were looking at... but when the light hit it—you could see clearly. That's exactly how life works.

When things feel confusing or hidden, it's like being in the dark. But when we bring things into the light, we can see what's true and make wise choices.

And we are not on our own.

God gave us a helper.

MEDIA SLIDE: Call and Response Slide

Who is our helper? **KIDS: The Holy Spirit!**

That's right!

The Holy Spirit helps guide us and shows us what is right.

So when something feels off... when something feels confusing or uncomfortable... that's a signal.

What do we call that? **KIDS: Red flag!**

Yes!

And when a red flag goes off, we don't ignore it—we take action.

When you notice a red flag, what do you do? **KIDS: Stop and tell!**

That's it—stop and tell mom or dad.

Let's say it together one more time:

When I see a red flag... **KIDS: I stop and tell!**

And why do we do that?

Because we bring things into the light

Because we bring things into the light.

When we bring things into the light, what happens? **KIDS: We can see clearly!**

Yes! And we can make wise choices.

HOST (more encouraging, personal):

You don't have to figure everything out on your own. God gave you the Holy Spirit to guide you.

And He gave you parents and trusted adults to help you walk in the light.

So this week, if something feels off—don't hide it. Bring it into the light.

Because when we walk in the light... we live the way God designed us to live.



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GAME

GAME- GUESS THE GLO (5 minutes)

SUPPLIES: Large opaque box (1 per group), Table (1 per group), Glow bottles (10 per group), Glow stick on a string (1 per group) *NOTE: Set the table in the center of the front of the room and place the box on the table with the opening facing the audience. Place five of the bottles inside the box and the matching five bottles on top of the box.

MEDIA SLIDE: LetsGlo_GuesstheGlo

Host: Our next game will involve a little detective work. We will place five glowing bottles inside the box. Four players, standing behind the box, will take turns trying to figure out the pattern. The first player will place the other five glowing bottles on top of the box in the first attempt to match the pattern of the bottles inside the box. The audience will say how many bottles are in the correct place. Then the next player will adjust the bottles, trying to also guess the pattern. Again, the audience will say how many are correct. We will keep going until one player gets the pattern correct! Players, you will want to pay close attention to what the player before you guesses and how many are correct! Let's get four players to the front! (Select players (1 from each group if possible, and welcome them to the front. Invite the players to introduce themselves, sharing their names and the names of the people they are here with.)

Players, stand side by side behind the box. (Allow time.) Now, I will arrange the five bottles side by side inside the box so the audience can see the pattern, but you cannot. (Arrange the bottles.) Players, are you ready? (Allow response.) Audience, let me hear you say, "Let's glo!" (Let's glo!)

(Keep the energy high, announcing the correct placement of bottles along with the audience. Stop the game when someone guesses the correct pattern.)

Our winner is ____! Here is your victory glow stick. (Distribute the glow stick on a string to the winner.) Let's cheer for our players as they return to their seats.

MEDIA SLIDE: Dismissal Slide

LEADER TIP: Consider playing multiple rounds if the game goes quickly or if you want to allow more players to participate. Small group leaders will pass out the coloring pages and help kids connect to their families.

DISMISS- Your group leader is going to walk with you to the auditorium to find your family. Please stay with your group leader until you find your family.
