Social Game

5 Minutes- Glo Hunt Game

Supplies: Glo Hunt pictures set (1 set per group), Glo Hunt Card Set (1 set per group), bucket (1 per group)

Game Setup: Tape the Glo Hunt pictures to the walls, ensuring they are not too high for kids to reach. Place Glo Hunt Cards in the buckets. Divide the group into 2 teams.

What to Do:

- Invite a kid to draw a card from the bucket and read it.
- The first player on each team will race to find the picture and bring back to their team.
- Players will take turns until all the cards and pictures are returned.
- The winner is the team with the most pictures.

SAY: Welcome, everyone! My name is ____, and it is "glo" awesome that you are here! Turn to some people, introduce yourself, give them a high five, and say, "Let's glo!" (*Allow time.*) It is time for some nifty neon fun. We are going to play some games together as a group. We will also have some opportunities for players who are ready to "glo" up front and play in some friendly competition.

Video

5 Minutes- God's Super Helper

What to Do: Here's the big idea for tonight—everything we're doing is about light. We're learning how to bring things into the light and understand what that means for our lives and our families. So let's start here—when you think about light or things that glow, what comes to your mind? Turn to your small group and share your ideas. Ready... go! (*Allow time.*)

Alright, I'm hearing some great answers! Now let's get ready for our next part. Eyes up front—it's time to watch a video together.

PLAY: "God's Super Helper"

SAY: That was awesome. Did you catch any of those glowing or light moments? In the video, we heard about a Super Helper that God sent. Jesus told His disciples that even though He was going back to heaven, they wouldn't be alone. He sent the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit helps us, guides us, and shows us what is right and wrong. And just like we saw light in the video, the Holy Spirit helps us see clearly and understand God. Jesus even said He is the Light of the World. Now it's your turn to talk about it.

Discussion

5 Minutes

- What did you see in the video that glowed or had light around it or in it?
- What does seeing light or glowing things make you think of?
- How do you think light shows you something about God?

Activity

10 Minutes- Light Sabers Craft

Supplies: pool noodle (2 foot long- 1 per kid), flashlight (1 per kid), duck tape, Red Flag Posters (taped to wall around your space- 1 set per group)

What to Do: Tonight we are talking about shining light on some words or things we see. So that we can shine our lights, we need to make some light sabers. Who's ready to build a light saber with me?

- Give each kid a pool noodle section and flashlight.
- Encourage them to push the flashlights into the pool noodle enough to make the noodle glow.
- Help them tape their flashlight in place.

SAY: Now we have our tools ready to shine bright on some flags I have posted around the room. Let's go over a few simple rules for our light sabers. Repeat after me. My light shines on the poster. (My light shines on the poster) My saber only swings in the air. (My saber only swings in the air.)

Game

5 Minutes- Red Flag Reporting

SAY: In this game, we are going to look for red flags around our space. When you find a red flag, we're going to shine a light on it—because we bring red flags into the light. Remember red flags are things we see, hear or find that we don't know or if a person asks us to keep a secret. When we find a red flag we are going to put our hands up and say, "STOP! Tell a trusted adult!"

If it's not a red flag, don't shine your light.

So get ready—lights up! (Kids will use their light saber as a light. Ask kids to shine the light on the poster when they see a red flag.)

Let's see how good you are at spotting red flags and bringing them into the light!

Alright, that was awesome. You did a great job spotting red flags and bringing them into the light. And did you notice something? When we shine light on something, it becomes easier to see what's really there.

Let's pray together, then you can work on your color page.

Father God, Thank You for giving us families we can trust. Help us shine lights on things we don't understand by sharing with our families. We love You. In Jesus' name, Amen.

Color Page

What to Do: Distribute the coloring pages and crayons. **Say:** We can trust our family and God to help us know what is right and wrong. God gives us all kinds of ways to know what to do and bring things to the light.

Allow time for kids to color.
