SOCIAL TIME

The first 10-15 minutes as kid's arrive are some of our most important times to meet needs and show kids they are valued. This is why we provide strategic activities for you help engage with every kid as they arrive.

- You will also find 2 Social activities each week. ***Use one now and one at the end to redirect attention.*

Games and Music (10 minutes)

What You Need: Social Game Instruction Page including Roku Games, Bark Color Pages (several) crayons

What You Do:

- Play worship songs and other songs available on Roku during the Social Game or while kids are playing.
- Using the supplies and game instruction page, choose one game to play with the kids today.
- As you are playing, use this as a time to call each kid by name and learn their names well.

Say: That was a fun game to get us ready to watch our Bible video. Let's sit and listen to our story today."

Bible Story Video (10 minutes)

Thanks, Super Crew! In today's Bible story, we learned about a man named Samson. Samson was special to God, and Samson's strength came from God. God gave Samson great strength through his hair. When Samson was young, he fought against the enemies of God called the Philistines. But soon, Samson fell in love with a woman named Delilah. She tried to trick Samson to figure out where his strength came from. Several times Samson didn't tell her the truth, but eventually he told her where his strength came from, and she had his hair shaved off. Then Samson was taken prisoner. After a while his hair grew back a little, and God allowed him to destroy the Philistines by pushing over columns with all his might. Even though Samson made wrong choices, his life was special to God. God made Samson special from head to toe, and He made each of us special too. Our lives are special to God. Our Super Clue today is a growth chart. What is our Super Clue? (*A growth chart!*) A growth chart measures how tall we are growing. Each year of our lives, we grow bigger and stronger! A growth chart reminds us that our lives are special to God.

Let's talk and listen to God. This is called prayer. Ready? Let's pray in 3-2-1.

God, thank You for making our lives special to You. Help us remember that our lives are special to You even when we make wrong choices like Samson did. When we make wrong choices, we can ask You to forgive us, and You do. Thank You for making us special from head to toe. Amen.

Can you say the Big Deal with me?

Head to Toe! (*Point to head with both hands. Point down with both hands.*)

God Made Me Special! (*Bring fists to hips and strike a superhero pose.*)

I Am Growing- Game (20 minutes)

Preschoolers will participate in a relay to mark how tall they are on a growth chart.

Big Goal: Remember what is super about the Super Clue.

Leader Prep: Attach butcher paper sheets next to each other on a wall.

Supplies: "I Am Growing" printable (2 per group), Butcher paper (2 per group), Painter's tape (1 per group), Markers (2 per group), Adult scissors (1 per group)

What To Do: We are going to play a game called "I Am Growing!" What is it called? (*I Am Growing!*) Good job listening. Let's form two teams and line up across the room from the big sheets of butcher paper on the wall. Today's Super Clue is a growth chart. We have two growth charts on our wall. When I say, "Go," the first person in each line will come up to the growth chart and a leader will measure how tall you are and mark it with a marker and your name. After we measure you, you will say, "God made me special!" Then you will go to the back of your team's line and sit down. We will keep going until everyone on both teams gets a turn.

Keep It Going: Don't forget to measure the leaders. If the growth chart isn't that tall, allow preschoolers to guess the leaders' height.

Leader Tip: Be sensitive to preschoolers who might have a difficult time standing. Find a way to measure how tall they are as well. This might mean helping a preschooler to the wall on her turn, measuring the preschooler sitting in his wheelchair or using her walker, or using a string to measure his height and taking it to the wall to mark.

Loud And Clear: Wow! Playing our game was so much fun! It was great getting to see how tall everyone is, and I loved hearing how special God made each of you. Every year, you grow taller, bigger, and stronger, and a growth chart helps you track your growth. A growth chart reminds us that your life is special to God. Let's say, "**My life is special to God,**" together. Ready? "**My life is special to God.**"

Say:

- Who remembers what our Super Clue is today? *(a growth chart)*
- What does a growth chart help us remember? *(A growth chart shows how tall you are and how you grow year after year. It reminds us that your life is special to God.)*
- What was something you liked about Large Group?
- **My life is special to God.** Whose life was special in today's Bible story? *(Samson)*
- What did you learn about God today?
- Do you remember today's Big Deal? I'll say it first, and you say it after me. *(Use the motions below as you say the Big Deal.)* Here we go. Head to Toe! *(Head to Toe!)* God Made Me Special! *(God Made Me Special!)*

Keep It Going: Lead preschoolers in a march around the room, imitating the leader as they practice the Big Deal.

Big Deal Motions:

Head to Toe! *(Point to head with both hands. Point down with both hands.)*

God Made Me Special! *(Bring fists to hips and strike a superhero pose.)*

I had so much fun with you today. The Bible has so many great truths to teach us about how special our lives are to God. In our Bible story, Samson's life was special to God, even though he made wrong choices. Your life is special to God too. Thank you for learning with me today

Prepare kids to talk with their family about what they learned today.

- Pass out coloring pages for kids to take home.
- As family members arrive to pick up their kid, greet them and tell them one thing you noticed about their kid that day or something you talked to each kid about remembering this week.
- If there is time to chat with the family, ask how you can pray for them this week.
- Say bye to the kids and call them by name.
