## Social Game

**Supplies:** None

**What to Do:** *Leader says:* "Jesus can do amazing things!"

*Kids repeat:* "Amazing things!"

*You say a miracle, kids act it out:*

- "Jesus calmed the storm!" → kids sway like a storm, then freeze and go quiet
- "Jesus fed lots of people!" → pretend to eat and say "yum!"
- "Jesus helped people see!" → cover eyes, then open and say "I see!"
- "Jesus helped people walk!" → stomp feet or march

*Keep it fast—about 10–15 seconds each.*

*After each one, everyone jumps and shouts:* "WOW! Jesus can do anything!"

*"Jesus did amazing miracles because He is powerful and cares about people."*

**Leader Tip:** *Don't explain too much—movement + repetition is what makes it stick. If they're wiggly, you're doing it right.*

## Video

**What to Do:** We are going to watch a video now from a part of the Bible called the Gospels. Our story today is a group of stories Mark writes about Jesus and some of the miracles he and the other disciples saw. Our video today is going to talk about 3 miracles. Let's watch now.

**PLAY: "It's a Miracle"**

**SAY:** A bad storm and Jesus is sleeping? A very sick girl and Jesus holds her hand and says, get up? More than 5,000 people and Jesus is planning to feed them five pieces of bread and two fish? If it weren't Jesus in all these stories, I would have a hard time believing it could happen. Today we will keep talking about ways we can know that God will take care of things, even things we can't.

## Activity

### **Basket Scramble**

**Supplies:** basket (1 per group), random objects (enough for each kid to have one), stopwatch or timer

**What to Do:** After listening to Jesus speak all day, the thousands of people who had gathered to hear Him became very hungry. Jesus had compassion on His followers and performed a miracle to multiply the food.

After the people were full, the disciples scrambled around and picked up 12 baskets of leftover food!

Invite your class to play a game where they must scramble to gather all of the random items that have been placed on the floor. To begin, scatter 50 different small items on the floor.

Then, set your timer to one minute and see how many items the class can pick up during that time.

When the students are finished, scatter the items again and see how many objects the kids can pick up in even less time.

### **Discuss:**

- Was it hard to find every object on the floor? How does it make you feel to know that no matter what is happening in a person's life, God has compassion on that person?
- How do you hope God will open your heart to have compassion for others?
- What do you think was special about what Jesus did?
- What are some of your favorite things that God has provided for you?

**PRAY:** Dear God, your amazing miracles show us you can give us the food we need. Thank you for taking care of us and loving us. In Jesus' name, Amen.

## Color Page

**What to Do:** Distribute the coloring pages and crayons. **Say:** Jesus' kingdom is upside down. It goes from rules to relationship. We can show love to everyone, because of Jesus.

Allow time for kids to color.
