## Leader Notes

**Bible Passage:** God Made People- Genesis 1-2

**Bottom Line:** God Made Me in His Image

**Leader Context:** God made us in His image. He has designed us for a purpose, and He determines our identity because He created us and loves us. God set people apart as His most special creation. God made people different than other things He created by making them in His image.

**THE WIN FOR SUNDAY GROUPS:** Give kids a first look at The Bible, Jesus, and our need for a Savior by embracing their physical needs or engaging their interests. Use The Code when necessary to help redirect kids and build relationships.

### Games and Music (10 minutes)

**What You Need:** June 16 Social Instruction Pages, Game Sets, Roku Game Instructions, balloons (4-5 per group) Allergy Alert poster (latex allergy)

**What You Do:**

- Play worship songs and other songs available on Roku during the Social Game or while kids are playing.
- Using the supplies and game instruction page, choose one game to play with the kids today.
- As you are playing, use this as a time to call each kid by name and learn their names well.

**Say:** That was a fun game to get us ready to watch our Bible video. Let's sit and listen to our story today."

### Bible Story Video (10 minutes)

#### Bible Story Recap- Say This!

Thanks Super Crew and Bark!

God made Adam and Eve in His image. Made in God's image means that God made people like Him in some special ways so we can show other people what God is like. He didn't make animals or trees or stars in His image- only people! We can celebrate that we are made in God's image. Let's say "God made me in His image." Ready? 3-2-1! (*God made me in His image.*) Great job!

The Super Crew helped us understand that, just like a mirror shows a reflection of what we look like, we are made to be a reflection of what God is like. Does that mean that we have the same nose or hair as God? (*allow responses*) No, it doesn't. As believers it means the things we do and say should help others know what God is like. We can show others what God is like by being kind to them. We can show that we care by sharing with our friends or letting them go first when we play.

Let's pray and talk to God. We can thank Him for making us so special. When we pray we close our eyes and are quiet so we can focus on talking and listening to God. Let's pray in 3-2-1. "God, thank You for making us so special. Help us show You to others in the things we do and the things we say. Thank You for making us in Your image. Amen."

Can you say the Big Deal with me?

One of a Kind!(*hold 1 finger out in front of you*)

God (*Point Up*)

Made Me Special! (*show two thumbs up*)

Let's do that a few more times.

## Videos

**Made in His Image(20 minutes)**

**What You Need:** Made in His Image printable (front and back-1 per kid), Made in His Image Pictures (1 set per kid-cut out), glue sticks, crayons

**Say:**

You have some pictures in front of you and a blank paper. We are going to work together to figure out where you should glue your pictures. Hold up a copy of each picture. Ask kids if it was made in God's Image. (*only people are made in God's image*). Now you can take your glue stick and paste that picture to the correct side of the paper.

**Say :** The Bible tells us that God made a special world full of plants, animals, fish, birds, and people. Even though God made many things, He made people different than the other things He made. People were made like God- in His image. God made people like Him in some special ways so we can know Him and show other people what He is like. That is what it means to be made in God's image.

**Say:**

- What was our Super Clue today? (*a mirror*) What does it help us remember? (*Just like a mirror shows a reflection of what we look like, we are made to reflect what God is like.*)
- What was your favorite part of the Bible story?
- How did God made you one of a kind? What is special about you?
- God made me in His image. What is a way you can show or reflect what God is like to others? (*You can show others God's love and kindness.*)
- What is something you learned about God today?
- What can you tell your friends and families about this week?

Our Big Deal is, "One of a Kind! God Made Me Special!

One of a Kind! (*hold 1 finger out in front of you*)

God (*Point Up*)

Made Me Special! (*show two thumbs up*)

**Prepare kids to talk with their family about what they learned today.**

- Pass out coloring pages for kids to take home. If time allows provide coloring pages for kids to make for Father's Day cards.
- As family members arrive to pick up their kid, greet them and tell them one thing you noticed about their kid that day or something you talked to each kid about remembering this week.
- If there is time to chat with the family, ask how you can pray for them this week.
- Say bye to the kids and call them by name.
