## Leader Notes

**Bible Passage:** Remarkably Made- Psalm 139

**Bottom Line:** God's Made Me on Purpose

**Leader Context:** Psalm 139 says that we are remarkably and wonderfully made, which means that God made us special, unique, and one of a kind. God didn't make mistakes when He made us—He made masterpieces!

**THE WIN FOR SUNDAY GROUPS:** Give kids a first look at The Bible, Jesus, and our need for a Savior by embracing their physical needs or engaging their interests. Use The Code when necessary to help redirect kids and build relationships.

## Social

**Games and Music (10 minutes)**

**What You Need:** Instruction Page, Game Sets, Roku Game Instruction Page

**What You Do:**

- Play worship songs and other songs available on Roku during the Social Game or while kids are playing.
- Using the supplies and game instruction page, choose one game to play with the kids today.
- As you are playing, use this as a time to call each kid by name and learn their names well.

**Say:** That was a fun game to get us ready to watch our Bible video. Let's sit and listen to our story today."

**Bible Story Video (10 minutes)**

**Bible Story Recap- Say This**

That Psalm really helps us see that we are uniquely designed by God. King David was a man who loved and followed God. He knew God made him on purpose, and he praised God for making him remarkable and special. And we can know the exact same thing! Turn to a friend and say, "It's true!" (It's true) God made all of us on purpose and that means we are unique, wonderful, special creations.

God made us and loves us. He made a way to restore our relationship with Him. If you have any questions about believing in Jesus for life, please talk with me or another small group leader. We'd love to help you know more about God's great plan for you.

Let's pray together. Remember prayer is listening and talking to God.

Thank You, God, for making us on purpose. You have made us each different, unique, and remarkable. Thank You for sending Jesus so we can have a relationship with You and know the truth about who You are and who You made us to be. Help us to celebrate how You made us. Work through us to help others see the truth of who You are and how You made them. Amen."

## Videos

**Unique Prints (20 minutes)**

**What You Need:** Unique prints printable (1 per kid), Psalm 139 printable (1 per group), pencils, washable markers, Bibles, washable ink pads (optional) baby wipes (optional)

**What You Do:**

*Set out the supplies. Create an example of the craft ahead of time. Plan on kids washing their hands after they create the craft or providing baby wipes to clean off the ink.*

**Say:** "Our Bible story today came from Psalm 139. Let's open up to that psalm right now. *(Assist kids with locating Psalm 139 in their Bibles. Read Psalm 139:13-14 together.)* We're going to make something that helps us celebrate and remember the amazing and unique ways God made each of us. First, put your hand in the middle of your paper with your fingers spread apart, and trace your hand and wrist in the middle of your paper with your fingers spread apart, and trace your hand and wrist with your pencil. Once you do that, trace over the pencil with your marker. *(allow kids to complete this step.)*

Next, use your pencil to write Psalm 139:13-14 around your hand. Write up the left side of your wrist and then onto your pinky finger *(or thumb if you are left handed)* curving around each finger until you have completed the verses. *(allow kids to complete this step.)*

Final step! A very unique and special thing about us is our fingerprints! Each of us has fingerprints that are special and unique only to us God didn't give them to anyone else! Use the marker to color your fingertips on the hand you traced, then press each fingertip to the matching finger on your paper. *(Once kids complete this step, allow them to wash their hands or use the baby wipes to remove the ink. Consider using washable instead of markers for the fingerprints.)*

Your pictures look great. They are all special and unique because you are special and unique. God loves you so much, so you can trust Him when He says that you are uniquely designed. When you look at your picture, you can remember, "God made me on purpose!" Put your picture somewhere at home and know God made you on purpose, special, and unique because He loves you.

**Discussion Questions:**

- Let's name some different types of artists and creative people and rate each one on a scale of 1-10 if you'd like to make those creations or not. *(Allow answers. Consider using types of artists such as painters, sculptors, glass blowers, writers, chefs, online content creators and so forth.)* Why do you think people create in these different kinds of ways? *(Allow kids to answer and share your own answer.)*
- Play dough can help us remember that God made each and every one of us on purpose. What are some things you like about how God made you, your friends, and your family? *(allow kids time to answer and share your own answer.)*
- The Bible tells us that God made us on purpose, and that means we're uniquely designed. Let's open our Bibles to Psalm 139:14 and read about it together. *(Invite kids to open up their Bibles. Read the passage aloud or invite a kid who volunteers to read the passage aloud. Help kids find the passage so everyone can follow along together.)* What is this passage teaching us?
- We are wondrously made by God, which means every one of us is special and unique because God made us. How can this change the way we look at ourselves and at others? *(Answers may include we appreciate the way God made us, we trust that God has plans for us, we appreciate and value others because we know that God made them and so forth.)*
- God made you on purpose and loved you so much that He sent Jesus to die for your sins and come back to life- all so you could have a forever friendship with Him and be the person He made you to be. If you have questions about what it means to follow Jesus, you can talk to me. What are some unique ways that God made you, and how can you thank Him? *(Allow kids time to answer and share your own response.)*
- if you have friends wondering why they are the way they are, what could you tell them based off of what we learned today? *(Answers may include that God made them on purpose, God loves them and has a plan for them, they are remarkably and wondrously made because God made them, God doesn't make mistakes, and so forth.)* The Bible tells us we are uniquely designed. God made us on purpose. Because of how remarkable God is, we are remarkably made!

God made you! God loves you and made you just the way He wanted. You are uniquely designed by God.

**Going Home**

Pass out the coloring pages for kids to take home. Greet families as they arrive and tell them something about their child you saw today. Say goodbye and call everyone by name.
