## I Am Uniquely Designed 1 year olds - 4 year olds

### Leader Notes

**Bible Passage:** God's Law- Exodus 20; Mark 12:28-34

**Bottom Line:** God Made Me for Relationship

**Leader Context:** Today we get to look at laws in both the Old and New Testaments about our relationships with God and others. When we look at the 10 Commandments in the Old Testament, we see two amazing things. The first four rules of the Ten Commandments show us how to have a relationship with God. The last six rules are about our relationships with each other. In the New Testament we learn that we should love God with everything and love our neighbors as much as we love ourselves. We are made to be in a one-of-a-kind relationship with God and with other people.

**THE WIN FOR SUNDAY GROUPS:** Give kids a first look at The Bible, Jesus, and our need for a Savior by embracing their physical needs or engaging their interests. Use The Code when necessary to help redirect kids and build relationships.

### Games and Music (10 minutes)

**What You Need:** June 23 Social Instruction Pages, Game Sets, Roku Game Instructions, beanbag

#### What You Do:

- Play worship songs and other songs available on Roku during the Social Game or while kids are playing.
- Using the supplies and game instruction page, choose one game to play with the kids today.
- As you are playing, use this as a time to call each kid by name and learn their names well.

**Say:** That was a fun game to get us ready to watch our Bible video. Let's sit and listen to our story today."

### Bible Story Video (10 minutes)

#### Bible Story Recap- Say This!

Thanks Super Crew!

Today we are learning a really exciting truth. We are learning that we are made for relationship with God and relationship with other people.

In the first part of our Bible story, we heard about 10 special rules God gave His people. The first 4 rules help us know how to have a relationship with God. Can you count to 4 with me? Let's all count together. Ready? God 1-2-3-4! Great job! These rules teach us to only love and worship God, treat His name with respect, and take time to rest and celebrate Him. The next 6 rules help us know how to have relationship with other people. Can you count to 6? Ready? Go! 1-2-3-4-5-6! These rules help us to know how to love others well.

In the second part of our Bible story, we heard two special rules that help us live in relationship with God and others. First, we are to love God with all our heart, soul, mind, and strength. Second, we are to love others like we love ourselves. I'm so thankful God made us for relationship. We can have friendship with God and with other people.

Let's pray and talk to God. We can thank Him for making us so special. When we pray we close our eyes and are quiet so we can focus on talking and listening to God. Let's pray in 3-2-1. "God, thank You for making us for relationship with You and with other people. Help us love You with our heart, soul, mind and strength. Help us love other people and be a good friend."

Can you say the Big Deal with me?

One of a Kind!(hold 1 finger out in front of you) God (Point Up) Made Me Special! (show two thumbs up)

Let's do that a few more times.

### Videos

**Flower Garden(20 minutes)**

**What You Need:** Flower Cutouts (purchased from Amazon) Bulletin Board Set & Paper (purchased from Amazon), glue dots, crayons, markers, paint sticks  
*Place bulletin board paper in the hallway near the group space. Place a few of the bulletin board decorations on it. Kids will add their flowers to the garden to make a special art piece for others to enjoy.*

**Say:**

I love flowers! Do you like flowers? What color flowers do you like? (allow responses) I am going to give each of you a flower cutout and crayons, markers or a paint stick. Once you get your paper, you can use the supplies to decorate your flower. When you're finished drawing and coloring your flower, bring it to me and I'll give you a few glue dots on the back. Then I want you to place your flower in the garden paper out in the hallway.

**Say :** God created us to be in relationship, and just like these beautiful flowers, we are better together. One flower by itself was pretty, but when we put all of our flowers together, we made a beautiful flower garden. God has made us so that we are connected to God and other people through relationships. Remember, having a relationship means you are connected to someone in a special way, like your family or even a friend. God made each one of us for relationship with God and with other people. God made us special, and He wants to be our friend. We need relationships with our friends and with God.

**Say:**

- What was our Super Clue today? *(a seesaw) What does it help us remember?(Just like you need two people to play on a seesaw, we are made for relationship with God and other people. Having a relationship means you are connected to someone in a special way, like your family or even a friend. God made each one of us for relationship with Him and with other people. God made us special, and He wants to be our friend.)*
- What was your favorite part of the Bible story?
- How did God made you one of a kind? What is special about you?
- God made me for relationship Who are some good friends God has given you?
- What is something you learned about God today?
- What can you tell your friends and families about this week?

Our Big Deal is, "One of a Kind! God Made Me Special!

One of a Kind! *( hold 1 finger out in front of you)*

God *(Point Up)*

Made Me Special! *(show two thumbs up)*

"God made us for relationship, and those relationships are all around us- our family, our friends, our teachers, our leaders, and our pastors. God wants us to learn more about Him from others, and He also wants us to tell others about Him too."

**Prepare kids to talk with their family about what they learned today.**

- Pass out coloring pages for kids to take home.
- As family members arrive to pick up their kid, greet them and tell them one thing you noticed about their kid that day or something you talked to each kid about remembering this week.
- If there is time to chat with the family, ask how you can pray for them this week.
- Say bye to the kids and call them by name.
