### Leader Weekly Devotion

**Bible Passage:** Saul learned about Jesus- Acts 9

**Bottom Line:** I can stand up.

**Leader Context:** Paul was transformed when he encountered Jesus on the road to Damascus, and his transformation led to a boldness to share the gospel. We get to teach kids that following Jesus means standing up for Him, by boldly and passionately sharing Him with those around us.

**THE WIN FOR SUNDAY GROUPS:** Give kids a first look at The Bible, Jesus, and our need for a Savior by embracing their physical needs or engaging their interests. Use The Code when necessary to help redirect kids and build relationships.

**Read-** Acts 9

**Highlight:** Acts 9 :19-20

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**Reflect-** How can I stand up and proclaim Jesus this week?

- Speak with kindness and show love to others around me.
- Be intentional to spend time with someone who doesn't follow Jesus.
- Share my story of how Jesus has changed my life with someone who hasn't heard it already.

**Pray:** God, thank You for sending Your Son, Jesus, and for working through us to share the gospel with those around us. Help us stand out from the world and stand up for You.

**Prepare:** What is your story about who you were before you started following Jesus, how you started following Him and what your life is like now?

This month we are helping kids know who they are, their identity by knowing God set them apart. For kids to know this truth and practice it they need to know and love God.
