Leader Notes

Bible Passage: The Prophets Told About Jesus- Isaiah 7:14, 9:6-7,11 Micah 5:2

Bottom Line: Jesus is the Greatest Hope

Leader Context: This December, we get to celebrate the gift of Jesus and Christmas with the Simple Truth, "I Am Never Alone." Kids can see the identity of this promise reflected in the identity of Jesus. This Christmas season, kids will learn that Jesus made a way for us to be with God forever.* Today, we are teaching kids about some of the names and characteristics spoken about Jesus. (Read Isaiah 9:6.) God promised to send a Savior who would bring comfort, power, peace, and eternal life. Kids will learn they can have hope that God is always with them because He promised—and God always keeps His promises!

THE WIN FOR SUNDAY GROUPS: Give kids a first look at The Bible, Jesus, and our need for a Savior by embracing their physical needs or engaging their interests. Use The Code when necessary to help redirect kids and build relationships.

Study

Read: Isaiah 7:14; 9:6; Micah 5:2

Highlight: Isaiah 9:6

Reflect: How can the names of Jesus bring you hope?

1. I can celebrate who Jesus is.
2. I can reflect on how Jesus has changed my life.
3. I can ask Jesus to help me grow in Him.

Pray: God, I celebrate the promises of the Savior written so long ago. Thank You that Your promises always come true. Help me to keep my focus on You. Amen.

Connect: Looking at the names of Jesus in Isaiah 9:6 (Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, Prince of Peace), which one gives you hope right now and why?
