Leader Weekly Devotion

Leader Notes

Bible Passage: Philip and the Ethiopian Official- Acts 8:26-40

Bottom Line: God Shows us Himself through His book.

Leader Context: Just like the Ethiopian official in Acts 8, we can know God more by reading His word, the Bible. We can help kids know they don't have to be older or wiser to read God's Word, they can start today. We can be intentional about reading the Bible too. The Bible is for each of us, not just pasors or people who go to Bible school. We don't need to be intimidated because God wrote the Bible to be understood by all of us.

THE WIN FOR SUNDAY GROUPS: Give kids a first look at The Bible, Jesus, and our need for a Savior by embracing their physical needs or engaging their interests. Use The Code when necessary to help redirect kids and build relationships.

Read- Acts 8: 26-40

Highlight: Acts 8:35

- Read Acts 8:26-40 and Psalm 8 this week. Ask God to teach you and give you a greater desire to read His word.
- Write down and memorize Deuteronomy 4:35b. When you read the verse, remind yourself that you are meant to know God and have a personal intimate relationship with Him.
- Talk with a friend or family member about what God is teaching you through His Word.

Pray: God, thank You for Your inspired and perfect Word. Remind us that the Bible is still active today and that You continue to reveal Yourself and draw us close to You as we read and study.

Prepare: What a Bible verse that encourages you that you can share with others?
