Leader Notes

Bible Passage: The Unknown God - Acts 17

Bottom Line: God shows Us Himself through His people.

Leader Context: God shows us Himself through His people. The book of Acts is such a great example of how God used His people to share the gospel story. We will look at Acts 17 and hear how Paul boldly shared Jesus and showed people who God is.

THE WIN FOR SUNDAY GROUPS: Give kids a first look at The Bible, Jesus, and our need for a Savior by embracing their physical needs or engaging their interests. Use The Code when necessary to help redirect kids and build relationships.

Read- Acts 17:16-34

Highlight: Acts 17:32-34

God shows us Himself through His people. The book of Acts is such a great example of how God used His people to share the gospel story. We will look at Acts 17 and hear how Paul boldly shared Jesus and showed people who God is.

Reflect- What is a way that you can allow God to work through you to show Himself to others?

- Offer to help someone in need and share that it's because of my faith.
- Lead a devotional time with family and friends, reading through Acts 17:16-34 and asking them the Reflect and Prepare questions provided here.
- Spend time with an older Christian and ask for wisdom on how to show the love of Jesus to others.

Pray: God, thank You for inviting us to participate in Your good works. You don't need us, but You chose us to make Your name great. What a gift it is to tell people about Jesus! Help us to be open to opportunities and ready to share, especially with our kids.

Prepare: We are made to know God because God loves us and wants a deeper relationship with us. What's a story of someone who shared Jesus with you and how it changed your life?

Study

Names are valuable. Knowing and saying kid's names correctly shows them they are seen and known. The same is true throughout the Bible as we look at God's character. His names show us His character.
