Bible Passage: Jesus Calmed the Storm- Mark 4:35-41

Bottom Line: God controls the world.

Leader Context: Jesus controlled the wind and the waves when He was on the sea with the disciples. This story reminds us that God controls the entire world. Even the wind and the waves.

THE WIN FOR SUNDAY GROUPS: Give kids a first look at The Bible, Jesus, and our need for a Savior by embracing their physical needs or engaging their interests. Use The Code when necessary to help redirect kids and build relationships.

Read- Mark 4:35-41

Highlight: Mark 4:39-40

Reflect- How can you remember that God controls the world this week?

- Spend time praying for other Christians around the world.
- Encourage a friend by reminding them that God is in control.

Pray: God, You are powerful, and You are good. Help me understand that You are in control when I feel like the world is full of chaos. May I rest in you and trust that no matter what happens, You are in control. Amen.
