Bible Passage: The Story of the Lost Son- Luke 15:11-32

Bottom Line: God's Love Never Gives Up

Leader Context: God's love never gives up. We see a great example of that in the parable of the lost son. There is no limit to God's love, and we can never run too far from Him.

THE WIN FOR SUNDAY GROUPS: Give kids a first look at The Bible, Jesus, and our need for a Savior by embracing their physical needs or engaging their interests. Use The Code when necessary to help redirect kids and build relationships.

Read- Luke 15:11-32

Highlight: Luke 15:22-24

Reflect- What's a way that you can appreciate and celebrate the truth that God's love never gives up?

- Spend time journaling about ways you've seen God's faithful love during different moments in your life.
- Take time to pray and forgive someone else, remembering that God always loves and forgives you, and He invites you to do the same with others.

Pray: God, thank You for Your never-ending love. Thank You that I can never stray too far from Your love. Help me to find hope, joy, and peace because of who You are and how much You love me.

Prepare: There is no limit to God's love. How can the limitless love of God help you when you are struggling or when you've made a mistake?
