SOCIAL TIME

The first 10-15 minutes as kid's arrive are some of our most important times to meet needs and show kids they are valued. This is why we provide strategic activities for you help engage with every kid as they arrive.

- This month you have Wiggle and Giggle Game cards and Suction Toys.
- You will also find 2 Social activities each week. ***Use one now and one at the end to redirect attention.*

Games and Music (10 minutes)

What You Need: Social Game Instruction Page including Roku Games, "Find The Pair" (1 set of cards per group)

What You Do:

- Play worship songs and other songs available on Roku during the Social Game or while kids are playing.
- Using the supplies and game instruction page, choose one game to play with the kids today.
- As you are playing, use this as a time to call each kid by name and learn their names well.

Say: That was a fun game to get us ready to watch our Bible video. Let's sit and listen to our story today."

Bible Story - Say This!

Thanks, Super Crew! In our Bible story, we learned that God is just and kind. Just means that God always does the right thing. Kind means that God is good and loving, and He wants us to know Him! Because of people's wrong choices, God sent a flood to wipe away everyone and everything on earth. But, God kept Noah, his family, and at least two of every kind of animal safe. God put a rainbow in the clouds to remind people of His promise to never destroy the earth again by a flood. Our Super Clue today is a rainbow. A rainbow in the sky reminds us of God's promise to Noah. God wants us to know Him, and one thing we can know about God is that He always does what is right and best.

Let's talk and listen to God. This is called prayer. Ready? Let's pray in 3-2-1.

God, thank You that You are always just and kind. Thank You for the rainbow you put in the clouds to remind us that You always keep Your promises. Thank You for helping us learn to follow Jesus so we can know You more. Amen.

Can you say the Big Deal with me?

Ready, Set, Grow! *(Spread hands in front of body making a circle with palms facing out.)*

God Wants Me to Know Him! *(Push hands up to the sky with palms facing each other.)*

Bible Story Video (10 minutes)**Dot a Rainbow Craft (20 minutes)**

Preschoolers will use dot stickers to make a rainbow.

Big Goal: Remember the Bible story.

Leader Prep: Print "Dot A Rainbow" printables, one per child.

Supplies: "Dot A Rainbow" printable (1 per child), Colored dot stickers (several), Markers or crayons (several; optional), Dot A Rainbow Craft Instructions and Example

Craft Instructions:

1. Before the session, print "Dot A Rainbow" printables, one per child.
2. Give each preschooler a rainbow printable and colored dot stickers.
3. Instruct preschoolers to fill in the circles on the rainbow with dot stickers.

What To Do: Let's make a rainbow dot craft! What kind of craft? *(A rainbow dot craft!)* Good! For this craft each of you will get a paper with a rainbow on it. Then you will get some dot stickers to add colors to your rainbow. On your rainbow craft you can see the different circles where you will want to place your dots. On one line of circles, you may only want to use red, and on another line you may only want to use blue to make the colored stripes of a rainbow. You can follow the circles on the page to know where to place your dots. As you create, share the colorful dots with your friends. Let's get started!

Keep It Going: As preschoolers fill in their rainbows, invite them to tell something they remember about the Bible story. Lay out markers or crayons for preschoolers who finish stickers quickly. They can color the white parts of their rainbow.

Loud And Clear: A rainbow in the sky reminds us of God's promise to never destroy the earth by flood again. God wants us to know Him. We can know that **God is just and kind.**

Say:

1. Who remembers what our Super Clue is today? (*a rainbow*)
2. What does a rainbow help us remember? (*A rainbow is God's promise to never destroy the earth by flood again. It reminds us that **God is just and kind.***)
3. What was something you liked about Large Group?
4. **God is just and kind.** What does it mean that **God is just and kind**? (*God is just means that God always does the right thing. God is kind means that God is good and loving.*)
5. What did you learn about God today?

Keep It Going: Invite preschoolers to find a friend and face each other as they say the Big Deal. When you call out, "Switch," lead them to find a different friend and say the Big Deal again.

Big Deal Motions:

Ready, Set, Grow! (*Spread hands in front of body making a circle with palms facing out.*)
 God Wants Me to Know Him! (*Push hands up to the sky with palms facing each other.*)

The story of Noah and the ark teaches us that **God is just and kind**. *Just* means that God always does the right thing. *Kind* means that God is good and loving. That reminds me of our Big Deal, "Ready, Set, Grow! God Wants Me to Know Him!" We can be thankful that God wants us to know Him.

Prepare kids to talk with their family about what they learned today.

- Pass out coloring pages for kids to take home.
- As family members arrive to pick up their kid, greet them and tell them one thing you noticed about their kid that day or something you talked to each kid about remembering this week.
- If there is time to chat with the family, ask how you can pray for them this week.
- Say bye to the kids and call them by name.
