SOCIAL TIME

The first 10-15 minutes as kid's arrive are some of our most important times to meet needs and show kids they are valued. This is why we provide strategic activities for you help engage with every kid as they arrive.

- This month you have Wiggle and Giggle Game cards and Suction Toys.
- You will also find 2 Social activities each week. ***Use one now and one at the end to redirect attention.*

Games and Music (10 minutes)

What You Need: Social Game Instruction Page including Roku Games, "Music/Theme Song and music player, flashlight (1 per group)

What You Do:

- Play worship songs and other songs available on Roku during the Social Game or while kids are playing.
- Using the supplies and game instruction page, choose one game to play with the kids today.
- As you are playing, use this as a time to call each kid by name and learn their names well.

Say: That was a fun game to get us ready to watch our Bible video. Let's sit and listen to our story today."

Bible Story - Say This!

Thanks, Super Crew! In our Bible story we learned that God is wise. Wise means knowing and doing the right thing. When no one could tell the king what his dream was and what it meant, Daniel and his friends prayed to God. God, in His wisdom, told Daniel what the dream was and what it meant so the king would know what is true about God—He is wise and powerful.

Today's Super Clue is stars. When we are outside at night, stars can help us see where to go. Wisdom helps us make good choices and know the right things to do. God wants us to know Him, and we can know is that He is wise and always makes the right choices.

Let's talk and listen to God. This is called prayer. Ready? Let's pray in 3-2-1.

God, thank You that You are wise. Thank You for helping us grow in our faith by knowing You. Amen.

Can you say the Big Deal with me?

Ready, Set, Grow! *(Spread hands in front of body making a circle with palms facing out.)*

God Wants Me to Know Him! *(Push hands up to the sky with palms facing each other.)*

Bible Story Video (10 minutes)**Truths About God Craft (20 minutes)**

Preschoolers will create a flower craft to remind them of truths about God.

Big Goal: Connect truths about God to the Bible story.

Leader Prep: Print "Truths About God" printable, one per child. Cut out petals. Make a sample.

Supplies: "Truths About God" printable (1 per child), Adult scissors (1 per group), Glue sticks (1 per child), Crayons (several), Truths About God Craft Instructions and Example

Craft Instructions:

1. Before the session, print "Truths About God" printable, one per child. Cut out petals. Make a sample.
2. Give each preschooler a flower printable, a set of five petals, crayons, and a glue stick.
3. Invite preschoolers to color the flowers.
4. Instruct preschoolers to glue the petals onto their flowers.

What To Do: Let's do a craft called "Truths about God." What is this craft called? *(Truths about God!)* That's right! For this craft each of you will get a set of flower petals that share truths about God. These truths include **God is wise**, *God is holy*, *God never changes*, *God is just*, and *God is kind*. First, you will use crayons to color your flowers. Then you will glue each petal on the flower.

Keep It Going: Guide preschoolers to share truths about God that they remember from the Bible story.

Leader Tip: Review the five truths about God on the petals with preschoolers as they complete their craft.

Loud And Clear: Your flowers with truths about God look awesome! They will be a great way to share these truths with your family and friends. Today we are learning the truth that **God is wise**. Daniel was used by God to help the king know what is true about God. Daniel helped the king know that **God is wise**..

Say:

1. Who remembers what our Super Clue is today? (*stars*)
2. What do stars help us remember? (*Stars give light to show us where to go just like wisdom helps us make good choices and know the right thing to do.*)
3. What was something you liked about Large Group?
4. **God is wise.** What does **God is wise** mean? (*God always makes the right choices.*)
5. What did you learn about God today?

Keep It Going: Form two teams of preschoolers. Lead teams to alternate between leading the Big Deal and repeating the Big Deal.

Big Deal Motions:

Ready, Set, Grow! (*Spread hands in front of body making a circle with palms facing out.*)
 God Wants Me to Know Him! (*Push hands up to the sky with palms facing each other.*)

Today we learned today that **God is wise.** God always makes the right choices. When we have wisdom, we can make good choices and know the right thing to do. In our Bible story, Daniel and his friends prayed to God. In His wisdom, God told Daniel about the king's dream so the king would know what is true about God. Let's say, "**God is wise,**" together. "**God is wise!**" Excellent!

Prepare kids to talk with their family about what they learned today.

- Pass out coloring pages for kids to take home.
- As family members arrive to pick up their kid, greet them and tell them one thing you noticed about their kid that day or something you talked to each kid about remembering this week.
- If there is time to chat with the family, ask how you can pray for them this week.
- Say bye to the kids and call them by name.
