SOCIAL TIME

**The first 10-15 minutes as kid's arrive are some of our most important times to meet needs and show kids they are valued. This is why we provide strategic activities for you help engage with every kid as they arrive.**

**Games and Music (10 minutes)**

*What You Need:* Social Game Instruction Page including Roku Games, "Hop To It" printable (! set per group), painter's tape

**What You Do:**

- Play worship songs and other songs available on Roku during the Social Game or while kids are playing.
- Using the supplies and game instruction page, choose one game to play with the kids today.
- As you are playing, use this as a time to call each kid by name and learn their names well.

**Say:** That was a fun game to get us ready to watch our Bible video. Let's sit and listen to our story today."

**Bible Story - Say This!**

Thanks, Super Crew! In our Bible story today, God made faithful promises to His people, and He kept all of His promises. A faithful promise is a statement that you will do what you say you will do. God wants us to know Him. We can know that God never changes and always keeps His promises.

An evergreen tree is a tree that is green all year long. Its leaves do not change colors and fall off like the leaves of other trees do in the fall season. God wants us to know Him, and one thing we can know about God is that He stays the same forever. God never changes.

*Let's talk and listen to God. This is called prayer. Ready? Let's pray in 3-2-1.*

*God, thank You for Your faithful promises and that You never change. Thank You for sending Jesus so we can know You. Thank You that we can trust You always. Amen.*

Can you say the Big Deal with me?

Ready, Set, Grow! *(Spread hands in front of body making a circle with palms facing out.)*

God Wants Me to Know Him! *(Push hands up to the sky with palms facing each other.)*

**Bible Story Video (10 minutes)****Promise Band Craft (20 minutes)**

Preschoolers will create two promise wristbands by twisting chenille stems together. They will make one to keep and one to give to a friend.

**Big Goal:** Connect to the Bible story.

**Supplies:** Chenille stems (4 per child), Promise Band Craft Instructions and Example

**Craft Instructions:**

1. Guide preschoolers to choose four chenille stems.
2. Demonstrate the following steps: twist two chenille stems together, wrapping them all the way to the end. Bend the twisted chenille stems and make a circle. Twist the ends together to connect the circle into a band.
3. Invite preschoolers to make two promise bands. Assist with twisting them as needed.

**What To Do:** Today's Bible story is full of God's promises for us. We can share these promises with others. We are each going to make two promise bands, one to keep and one to give away. What are we going to make? *(Promise bands!)* There are different colored chenille stems here. To make a promise band, choose two, twist them together, and then bend them into a circle, connecting the ends by twisting them together.

**Keep It Going:** Encourage preschoolers to share who they will give their second promise band to when they leave and what promise of God they will share with them.

**Leader Tip:** Assist preschoolers by starting the twist of their two chenille stems.

**Loud And Clear:** Hold up your promise bands, and let's see what you created. These look amazing! They can remind us that God made faithful promises to His people, and He kept all of His promises. He still keeps His promises today! God wants us to know Him—to know that He never changes and always does what He says He will do. That is good news we can share with someone else. When I say, "Go," I want you to shout out the name of who you are going to give one of your promise bands to. Ready? Go! *(Allow responses.)* That is so exciting!

## TALK IT OUT

### Say:

1. Who remembers what our Super Clue is today? (*an evergreen tree*)
2. What does an evergreen tree help us remember? (*Like the leaves on an evergreen tree stay green all year and do not fall off, **God never changes.** He stays the same forever.*)
3. What is something you liked about Large Group?
4. **God never changes.** How do we know **God never changes**? (*We learn in the Bible that **God never changes** and always keeps His promises.*)
5. What did you learn about God today?

**Keep It Going:** Say the Big Deal using different voices: soft, loud, mouthing the words, and shouting.

### Big Deal Motions:

Ready, Set, Grow! (*Spread hands in front of body making a circle with palms facing out.*)  
God Wants Me to Know Him! (*Push hands up to the sky with palms facing each other.*)

The evergreen tree reminds us that **God never changes.** He always keeps His promises. Evergreen trees are green all year long, and their leaves do not change. God wants us to know Him, and one thing we can know about God is that He never changes.

## GOING HOME

### Prepare kids to talk with their family about what they learned today.

- Pass out coloring pages for kids to take home.
- As family members arrive to pick up their kid, greet them and tell them one thing you noticed about their kid that day or something you talked to each kid about remembering this week.
- If there is time to chat with the family, ask how you can pray for them this week.
- Say bye to the kids and call them by name.
