**WIN**

**SOCIAL TIME**

**The first 10 minutes as kids arrive is a very important time in your small group. Because of this, we provide you with intentional activities to engage their interests and help lead into a great discussion. All of this is so that “boredom” is not an excuse. Everything is only available one time.**

Every week you have:

- Roku Games to play together that are changed out monthly.
- 2 month specific games or group activities.
- Plus 2 Social Activities. *\*\* Use one now and save the other for an incentive to participate in all the activities.*

**Games and Music (10 minutes)**

*What You Need:* Instruction Page, Game Sets, Roku Game Instruction Page, Dominos (10-20 per group)

**What You Do:**

- Play worship songs and other songs available on Roku during the Social Game or while kids are playing.
- Using the supplies and game instruction page, choose one game to play with the kids today.
- As you are playing, use this as a time to call each kid by name and learn their names well.

**Say:** That was a fun game to get us ready to watch our Bible video. Let’s sit and listen to our story today.”

## Bible Story Video (10 minutes)

### Bible Story Recap- Say This

Can you imagine what it must have felt like when those two disciples learned that they had been walking with Jesus the whole time? The Bible shows us through this story that we get to be a part of God's plan of sharing Jesus with others. After Jesus died on the cross and rose from the dead, the disciples had a lot of different feelings and questions. Jesus helped the disciples see that, not only was Jesus alive, but they were part of God's plan to help the world know the truth. And we can know that, when we trust and follow Jesus, sharing Jesus is God's plan for us too! **Say, "Sharing Jesus is God's plan!"** (*Sharing Jesus is God's plan!*)

### Gospel Connection: (refer to the 4 Circles poster in your small group spaces)

**(Circle 3)**- Jesus came as God's plan to make a way for us to have a relationship with Him. When the disciples realized Jesus was alive, their lives changed, and our lives can change too when we believe in Him.

**(Circle 2)**- Sin is when we choose our way instead of God's way, and it breaks our relationship with Him. That is why God sent Jesus, who lived a perfect life, died for our sin, and came back to life so we can be forgiven and know God.

**(Circle 4)**- When we turn away from sin and trust Jesus, we can know He is with us. God wants people everywhere to hear the truth about Jesus, and He can use us to help others know and follow Him.

**(Circle 1)**- God sent Jesus to rescue us from sin, and that is good news we can share with others. No matter how old we are, everyone who believes in Jesus can help tell others about Him.

If you want to know more about trusting and following Jesus, talk with me or your Campus Leader. We are here to share Jesus, and we would love to share Jesus with you.

We are here to share Jesus, and **sharing Jesus is God's plan!** Repeat after me: "I am here to share Jesus!" (*I am here to share Jesus!*) **"Sharing Jesus is God's plan!" (Sharing Jesus is God's plan!)** We never have to worry if we are old enough to share Jesus with others. When we follow Jesus, we can trust that God is with us. When we share Jesus with others, He will help us. Jesus makes the only way to have a relationship with God, and this truth is just too good to keep to ourselves! Let's close our time by praying and talking with God. Let's pray in 3-2-1.

*God, thank You for the truth that sharing Jesus is a part of Your plan. Thank You for the ways that You help us to share Jesus with our family, friends, and everyone we meet. Help us to have courage and boldness as we share Jesus and remind us that we are never too young to share this incredible truth. Amen.*

## Nonstop Love

Create a card with an infinity symbol and a funny message.

**Big Goal:** Make a reminder for mothers and special people that God loves us nonstop.

**Leader Prep:** Set out supplies.

1. Attach the infinity symbol to the cardstock with small loops of painter's tape on the side of your paper that says, "I Love You Nonstop and..."
2. Color over the whole paper and infinity symbol with crayons.
3. Remove the symbol and glue it on the side of your paper that says " God Loves You Nonstop and..." (creating one side that is *colorful* with a blank infinity symbol shape and one side that is blank with a *colorful* infinity symbol glued to it).

**Supplies:** "Nonstop Love" printable (on cardstock 1 per child), Markers or crayons (several), Painter's tape (1 per group), Glue sticks (1 per child), Infinity Symbol Cutout (1 per kid), "Nonstop Love Example" (1 per group)

**What To Do:** Today, we are making a special craft—a card that never stops to remind us that God's love never stops. This card is also an awesome reminder of how much our moms, or special people in our lives, love us. Let me hear you say, "Nonstop Love!" (*Nonstop Love!*)

I am going to pass out all your supplies. Once you get your infinity shape cutout, roll small pieces of painter's tape and tape your infinity symbol to one side of your cardstock paper. Press down the symbol so it is very flat. (*Allow time, assisting as needed.*)

Now we can get creative! Use crayons to color all over the side of the paper with the words "I Love You Nonstop and." including coloring over the symbol. Try and cover the whole paper, keeping that symbol flat against the paper. The reason is that when you remove the symbol, you will have a cool looking blank space in the shape of the infinity symbol! (*Allow time.*)

Finally, take off your colored infinity shape, remove the tape loops, and glue the shape on the middle of the other side of the paper. Now you will have one side with a *colorful* infinity symbol on it and one *colorful* side with a blank infinity symbol on it. Then give the card to your mom, or another special person, to read the message nonstop! (*Allow time.*)

**Leader Tip: Younger Option:** Precut and attach the infinity symbols to cardstock.

**Loud And Clear:** This card is special because it never ends—just like God's love for us. Whether this card is going to your mom, grandma, or someone special and important in your life, you can help that person know that God's love—and your love—is nonstop!

Let's chat about this more by looking at some questions that make us think deeper.

**Discussion Questions:**

- If you could plan the perfect weekend, what would you plan? Would you rather plan everything yourself or follow someone else's plan? *(Allow kids to answer and share your own answer.)* We can trust and follow God's plan because God knows best! **Sharing Jesus is God's plan.**
- If you stand up a line of dominos and then knock over the first one, what will happen? How can falling dominos help us remember what happens when we share Jesus? *(They fall! When we share Jesus with people, they can believe in Him and then share Jesus with others too. That is God's plan for us.)*
- The Bible tells us we are here to share Jesus, and that this is God's plan for our lives! Let's open our Bibles to **Luke 24:46-47** and read about it together. *(Invite kids to open their Bibles. Read the passage aloud or invite a kid who volunteers to read the passage aloud. Be sure to have Bibles available for kids who need one. Help kids find the passage so everyone can follow along together.)* Jesus reminded His disciples that it was always God's plan for Jesus to die and make the way for people to find forgiveness from sin. Because of Jesus, we can believe in Him, be forgiven of our sin, and share this truth with others Jesus also said that God's plan was for this truth to be shared everywhere! Where are different places you can share Jesus? What can happen in the lives of other people when you share Jesus with them? *(Allow kids to answer and share your own answer. Point out that, when we share Jesus, people can believe the truth and start a relationship with God.)*
- Why do you think it is good news that Jesus wants everyone to be a part of His family? *(The Bible tells us that Jesus died and rose again so we could be forgiven for our sin and be a part of God's family forever. This is the best news ever! We want everyone to experience this forgiveness too.)*
- The Bible tells us that **sharing Jesus is God's plan.** We learned today that God wants everyone to know Him, and He works through us to share that good news! What is something you learned today?

Is there anything you have questions about? *(Allow kids to answer, and share your own answer.)* Let's pray and talk to God. *(Lead the group in prayer. Consider using the following prayer prompt.)*

*God, thank You that Your big plan includes us. Thank You that You want us to be a part of Your family and that You work through us to share this good news with others. Help us to share Jesus everywhere we go! Help us remember we are never too young to share Jesus, and You are always with us, helping us share. This is all part of Your plan! Amen.*

When we share Jesus, we are part of God's plan to help others know Him. Like the disciples on the road to Emmaus, we get to tell others the good news that Jesus is alive! The news about Jesus forgiving sin is not just for us, it is for everyone!

**GOING HOME**

Pass out the coloring pages for kids to take home. Greet families as they arrive and tell them something about their child you saw today. Say goodbye and call everyone by name.
