**SOCIAL TIME**

**The first 10-15 minutes as kid’s arrive are some of our most important times to meet needs and show kids they are valued. This is why we provide strategic activities for you help engage with every kid as they arrive.**

- This month you have a Fishing Game and Obstacle Course
- You will also find 2 Social activities each week. *\*\*Use one now and one at the end to redirect attention.*

**Games and Music (10 minutes)**

*What You Need:* Social Game Instruction Page including Roku Games, Bark Color Pgs, crayons, Colored pom-poms (several), Clear buckets or bins (several), Construction paper (colors of pom-poms) (several), Tongs (1 per group; optional), Plastic cups (1 per kid)

**What You Do:**

- Play worship songs and other songs available on Roku during the Social Game or while kids are playing.
- Using the supplies and game instruction page, choose one game to play with the kids today.
- As you are playing, use this as a time to call each kid by name and learn their names well.

**Say:** That was a fun game to get us ready to watch our Bible video. Let’s sit and listen to our story today.”

**Bible Story - Say This!**

Thanks, Super Crew! In our Bible story we learned that sharing Jesus is worth it. Jesus told a story that taught how some people will hear about God's kingdom and believe, some will believe for a short time, and some will not believe. Even though not everyone who hears about Jesus believes in Him, sharing Jesus is worth it. We can tell people about Jesus here and now, wherever we go.

Our Super Clue today is a sunflower seed growing into a sunflower. When you plant a small sunflower seed, it can be very hard to wait for it to grow, but it is worth the wait when you see a beautiful sunflower bloom.

Sharing Jesus is worth it. When we tell someone about Jesus, we do not know if the person who hears will believe in Jesus or choose to follow Jesus. It can be scary sometimes to tell people about Jesus. Maybe we do not know what to say, or we are worried about what someone may say, but sharing Jesus is always worth it.

Let's pray and thank God for His plan. *Praying* is talking and listening to God. Ready? Let's pray.

*God, thank You for loving us and for sending Your Son, Jesus. Help us share about Jesus wherever we go. Amen.*

Can you say the Big Deal with me?

Here and Now! (*Point down with right finger, then with left finger.*)

God Wants Me to Tell People about Jesus! (*Bring hands to mouth, then push them out in front of you.*)

**Bible Story Video (10 minutes)****Seeds to Share- Craft (20 minutes)**

Preschoolers will decorate an envelope and fill it with sunflower seeds to give to a friend.

**Big Goal:** Remember the Main Idea: **Sharing Jesus is worth it.**

**Supplies:** "Seeds To Share" printable (1 per child), Crayons (several), 4-by-6-inch envelopes (1 per child), Plantable sunflower seeds (several), Glue sticks (1 per child), Tape (1 per group), Adult scissors (1 per group), "Seeds To Share Craft Instructions" (1 per group; optional)

**Craft Instructions:**

1. Before the session, print and cut out "Seeds To Share" printables, one per child.
2. Give each child an envelope and a printable.
3. Invite preschoolers to decorate their envelopes and printable with crayons.
4. Assist them in gluing the printable on the front of their envelopes.
5. Help preschoolers place a few sunflower seeds in their envelopes and seal them.

**What To Do:** Has anyone ever planted a seed before? (Allow responses.) It is so fun! We are going to make a craft with seeds. A craft with what? (Seeds!) The best part about our craft is that we get to give it away to someone who we want to share Jesus with. Each of you will get to decorate an envelope. Once your envelope is decorated, I will put a few sunflower seeds inside, and we will tape it shut. I have two things I would love for you to color—this card (hold up the "Seeds To Share" printable) and an envelope. This card reminds us that sharing Jesus is worth it. When you are finished coloring, we will help you glue your card onto your envelope, fill it with seeds, and tape it shut.

**Keep It Going:** Spend time talking about who preschoolers would like to give their envelopes to and talk about how they want to share Jesus with their friends.

**Leader Tip:** Watch the Gospel video to help talk about how we can share Jesus with others. Encourage the preschoolers to say things such as, "Jesus is God's Son. Jesus came so we can be forgiven and have a friendship with God. Jesus is very special. Jesus loves you."

**Loud And Clear:** Great job! I know your friends will love your sunflower packets. When we tell someone about Jesus, we do not know if the person who hears will believe in Jesus or choose to follow Him. It can be scary sometimes to tell people about Jesus. Maybe we do not know what to say, or we are worried about what someone may say, but **sharing Jesus is worth it!** Let's say that together. I will say it first, and you say it after me. Ready? **Sharing Jesus is worth it! (Sharing Jesus is worth it!)**

## TALK IT OUT

### Say:

- Who remembers what our Super Clue is today? (*A sunflower seed that grows into a sunflower*)
- What does a sunflower help us remember? (*Planting flowers are worth the wait and just like that, sharing Jesus is always worth it!*)
- What was something you liked about Large Group?
- **Sharing Jesus is worth it.** Where can we share about Jesus? (*anywhere!*)
- What did you learn about God today?

**Keep It Going:** Gather preschoolers in a circle and say the Big Deal word by word with each preschooler saying one word at a time.

### Big Deal Motions:

Here and Now! (*Point down with right finger, then with left finger.*)

## GOING HOME

### Prepare kids to talk with their family about what they learned today.

- Pass out coloring pages for kids to take home.
- As family members arrive to pick up their kid, greet them and tell them one thing you noticed about their kid that day or something you talked to each kid about remembering this week.
- If there is time to chat with the family, ask how you can pray for them this week.
- Say bye to the kids and call them by name.
