SOCIAL TIME

The first 10-15 minutes as kid's arrive are some of our most important times to meet needs and show kids they are valued. This is why we provide strategic activities for you help engage with every kid as they arrive.

- This month you have a Fishing Game and Obstacle Course
- You will also find 2 Social activities each week. ***Use one now and one at the end to redirect attention.*

Games and Music (10 minutes)

What You Need: Social Game Instruction Page including Roku Games, Bark Color Pgs, crayons, Dot stickers (assorted colors) (several) , Parachute or bed sheet (1 per group), Ball pit balls (several)

What You Do:

- Play worship songs and other songs available on Roku during the Social Game or while kids are playing.
- Using the supplies and game instruction page, choose one game to play with the kids today.
- As you are playing, use this as a time to call each kid by name and learn their names well.

Say: That was a fun game to get us ready to watch our Bible video. Let's sit and listen to our story today."

Bible Story - Say This!

Thanks, Super Crew! Our Bible story was about a special day called Pentecost. Let's say, "Pentecost," together. "Pentecost!" Wonderful! Jesus' friends and followers were filled with the Holy Spirit, and all the people listening heard that everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved. That day, three thousand people were saved, which means they believed in Jesus and asked Him to forgive them of their wrong choices. That is so exciting! We can tell people about Jesus here and now, wherever we go, too, because sharing about Jesus is exciting.

Our Super Clue today is a piñata, and the best part about a piñata is that the treats inside are for everyone at the party, not just the person who broke it open. Just like the treats, the good news about Jesus isn't just for us—it is for everyone. We get to share this super special news about Jesus here and now!

Let's pray and thank God for His plan. *Praying* is talking and listening to God. Ready? Let's pray.

God, I am so thankful that the good news about Jesus is for everyone and that You sent Jesus for all of us. Help us tell people about Jesus everywhere we go. Amen.

Can you say the Big Deal with me?

Here and Now! (*Point down with right finger, then with left finger.*)

God Wants Me to Tell People about Jesus! (*Bring hands to mouth, then push them out in front of you.*)

Bible Story Video (10 minutes)**Make a Pinata- Craft (20 minutes)**

Preschoolers will create a piñata using cardboard tubes and crepe paper streamers.

Big Goal: Remember what is super about the Super Clue.

Supplies: Cardboard tubes (1 per child), Glue sticks (1 per child), Crepe paper streamers (assorted colors) (several), Yarn (1 per group), Adult scissors (1 per group), Tape (1 per group), Child-safe scissors (1 per child), Make A Piñata Craft Instructions (1 per group)

Craft Instructions:

1. Before the session, cut strips of crepe paper streamers, several strips per child. Cut the strips to fit around the outside of the cardboard tubes you are using. Make a sample craft.
2. Invite preschoolers to use child-safe scissors to cut slits in the bottom of each crepe paper strip to create a "fringe" look.
3. Assist preschoolers in applying glue to their cardboard tubes, then wrapping each strip around the outside of the tube. Overlap the strips.
4. Cut a piece of yarn and assist each child in taping a loop on the top of the tube to make a hanger.

What To Do: Our Super Clue today is a piñata. What is our Super Clue? (*A piñata!*) You're right! It is a piñata. We are going to make piñatas to help us remember that the special news about Jesus is for everyone. Each of you will get a cardboard tube and strips of crepe paper. First, you will take scissors and cut little slits along the bottom of each crepe paper strip. Then we will help you glue the streamers around your cardboard tubes to make them look like piñatas. When you finish, we will tape a piece of yarn to the top to make a loop that you can use as a hanger.

Leader Tip: Preschoolers may need help gluing and overlapping the streamer strips.

Loud And Clear: Look at how fun all of your piñatas are! Piñatas are so exciting! Isn't it so much fun when you get a turn to try and open a piñata and see all the treats fall out? The treats are not just for one person—they are for everyone at the party. God wants us to tell people about Jesus, and sharing Jesus is so exciting. The special news about Jesus is not just for us—it is for everyone!

TALK IT OUT

Say:

- Who remembers what our Super Clue is today? (*a piñata*)
- What does a piñata help us remember? (*Just like the treats in a piñata are for everyone at a party, the special news about Jesus is for everyone!*)
- What was something you liked about Large Group?
- Today we learned that **sharing Jesus is exciting**. What can we share with people? (*God sent Jesus so we can be forgiven and have a friendship with God.*)
- What did you learn about God today?

Keep It Going: Lead preschoolers to turn to a friend and tell them the Big Deal. If time allows, they can turn to another friend and tell them the Big Deal.

Big Deal Motions:

Here and Now! (*Point down with right finger, then with left finger.*)

God Wants Me to Tell People about Jesus! (*Bring hands to mouth, then push them out in front of you.*)

In our Bible story today, we learned that on a special holiday called Pentecost, Peter told people that God would give His Spirit to people who believe and follow Jesus and that everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved. That day, three thousand people were saved and forgiven through Jesus. That is so exciting! We can tell people about Jesus here and now, wherever we go, because **sharing Jesus is exciting!**

GOING HOME

Prepare kids to talk with their family about what they learned today.

- Pass out coloring pages for kids to take home.
- As family members arrive to pick up their kid, greet them and tell them one thing you noticed about their kid that day or something you talked to each kid about remembering this week.
- If there is time to chat with the family, ask how you can pray for them this week.
- Say bye to the kids and call them by name.
