I Am Made for Community 1 year olds - 4 year olds

Leader Notes

Bible Passage: Priscilla and Aquila- Acts 18

Bottom Line: God connects us to each other.

Leader Context: God worked through Priscilla and Aquila to help others and grow the kingdom of God. It's amazing how God connects and unites us together- all with the commonality of loving and following Him. This week you get to share the amazing community kids can be part of when they believe in Jesus.

THE WIN FOR SUNDAY GROUPS: Give kids a first look at The Bible, Jesus, and our need for a Savior by embracing their physical needs or engaging their interests. Use The Code when necessary to help redirect kids and build relationships.

Social

Games and Music (10 minutes)

What You Need: Instruction Page, Game Sets, Roku Game Instructions

What You Do:

- Play worship songs and other songs available on Roku during the Social Game or while kids are playing.
- Using the supplies and game instruction page, choose one game to play with the kids today.
- As you are playing, use this as a time to call each kid by name and learn their names well.

Say: That was a fun game to get us ready to watch our Bible video. Let's sit and listen to our story today."

Bible Story Video (10 minutes)

Bible Story Recap- Say This!

Wow! Thanks Super Crew. Hope to see you again soon!

Those were come amazing things we learned from the Super Crew and the Bible story. We saw how a puzzle has pieces that connect together. God gives us friends and connects us to each other. God gave Paul Priscilla and Aquila to be his friends and to help him. God invites us to help each other. We can help friends here at church or friends in our communities. We can help each other learn more about Jesus. Everyone stand up and say our Big Deal with me (including the motions)

You're invited (point with both hands forward)

God gives Me friends (with palms up, move both hands in a small circle and end like you are holding a tray) Great job!

Let's pray right now and ask God to help us be good friends and help each other, like the friends in our Bible story... Let's all close our eyes and get really still so we don't get distracted and can focus on talking to God. Let's pray in 3-2-1.

"God, thank You for giving us friends. Help us to help each other and learn more about You, just like we saw in our Bible story. May we share with our friends more and more about Jesus.. Amen.."

Nov 19 1-4s Small Group

Stick Together(20 minutes)

What You Need: Stick together printable (1 per kid), tissue paper pieces (a handful for each kid), glue sticks, markers/crayons

What You Do:

- Hold up a copy of the printable. Do you see my person? He looks so plain. He needs some color. Today, we are going to glue tissue paper pieces inside of our person shapes until no blank spots are left. Use your glue stick to put glue inside the person outline on your paper, then put the tissue paper squares on top of the glue. You can use any colors you want and create any pattern you want.
- Spark creativity and allow preschoolers to use markers to draw faces and add hair or other details to their shapes. Encourage kids to share the tissue paper squares and help each other if they finish early. Encourage them to have fun and not worry about keeping the tissue paper in the lines.

Say "Your people look so good! I love them more now that you added some color to them. God connects us together like the tissue paper on your people. He gives us friends that we can help out and have fun with. Isn't it wonderful that God gives us friends?"

Say:

- What was our Super Clue today? *(a puzzle)* What does it help us remember? *(God gives us each other to help one another and when we work together, everything connects, just like the puzzle pieces.)*
- What was your favorite part of the Bible story?
- Paul, Priscilla, and Aquila all helped each other and helped others too. Who are some friends God has given you? How can you help them like the friends in our Bible story?
- What is something you learned about God today?
- What can you tell your friends and families about this week?

Our Big Deal is, "You're Invited! God Gives Me Friends"

You're Invited (point with both hands forward)

God gives me Friends (with palms up, move both hands in a small circle and end like you are holding a tray)

I am so glad that God gives us friends and connects us to each other. We can help our friends know more and more about Jesus. I am so glad that we are all invited to be God's friends. I hope you will look for ways to help each other."

Prepare kids to talk with their family about what they learned today.

- Pass out coloring pages for kids to take home.
- As family members arrive to pick up their kid, greet them and tell them one thing you noticed about their kid that day or something you talked to each kid about remembering this week.
- If there is time to chat with the family, ask how you can pray for them this week.
- Say bye to the kids and call them by name.
