God Forgives Me- Game Changer 1 year olds - 4 year olds

Leader Notes

Bible Passage: God Forgives Me- Genesis 3, John 3:16

Bottom Line: God always had a plan to restore us- Jesus is that plan!

Leader Context: The brokenness that came through Adam and Eve's disobedience is seen all around us today. But the amazing news is that God always has a plan to restore us- and that plan is Jesus! The good news of what Jesus has done and what it means for our lives gives us hope and new life.

THE WIN FOR SUNDAY GROUPS: Give kids a first look at The Bible, Jesus, and our need for a Savior by embracing their physical needs or engaging their interests. Use The Code when necessary to help redirect kids and build relationships.

Social

Games and Music (10 minutes)

What You Need: Instruction Page, Game Sets, Roku Game Instructions

What You Do:

- Play worship songs and other songs available on Roku during the Social Game or while kids are playing.
- Using the supplies and game instruction page, choose one game to play with the kids today.
- As you are playing, use this as a time to call each kid by name and learn their names well.

Say: That was a fun game to get us ready to watch our Bible video. Let's sit and listen to our story today."

Videos

Bible Story Video (10 minutes)

Say This!

Thank you, Super Crew! And hooray for our Big Deal today! Can you say the Big deal after me and do the motions I do?

Hooray (both palms out, make large circles with both arms in front of the body)

God forgives me! (two thumbs pointing to chest)

That's right! Each of us makes wrong choices, just like Adam and Eve did. Those wrong choices are called sin. And those wrong choices hurt our friendship with God. but hooray! God loves us so much that He sent His Son, Jesus, to forgive our sins.

We can pray to God and ask Him to forgive our sins and let Him know we love Jesus. And you what? He always says yes because He loves us so much. Hooray.

We are going to pray and talk to God right now. Close your eyes and let's stay nice and still so we don't get distracted. Let's pray in 3-2-1.

"God we are sorry that we make wrong choices. We know that those choices make you sad and hurt our friendship with You. We are so glad You sent Your Son, Jesus, to take the punishment for our sin. Help us to always remember that You love us and forgives us. Hooray! In Jesus. name we pray, Amen."

Oct 29 1-4s Small Group

Ready Confetti (20 minutes)

What You Need: Hooray Printable (1 per kid), paint daubers/sticks or markers (1 per kid)

What You Do:

- Let's make a picture that will remind us of our Big Deal- Hooray! God forgives me! Everyone take a paint stick/marker. When I say "Go" start drawing dots and lines that look like confetti or sprinkles on a cupcake. When I say "Stop" freeze where you are. When I say "switch" pass your paint stick/marker to the person on the right (*point to the right*) This way, everyone will get lots of colors of confetti on their papers, Ready? Set? Go! (*Allow kids to color until the colors have passed at least five or six times.*) Wow! Your papers look like a Hooray Day celebration! There's only one thing missing- you! Can you draw yourself standing and celebrating?
- This craft is a fun time to share, but if there is a preschooler who doesn't want to switch, don't force him. Rather, give him a couple of crayons and encourage him to use different colors.

Say "Hooray! This looks like a celebration! And what a great thing to celebrate. God loves us so much He sent His Son, Jesus, to take the punishment for our sins. God forgives our wrong choices when we ask Him, and that's an amazing thing to celebrate. Let's say our Big Deal Hooray! God Forgives Me! (*Hooray, God Forgives Me.*)

Say:

- Do you remember what was in our Super box today? (*a bandage*) And when we see a bandage, what can we remember? (*Our wrong choices make God sad. God forgives us.*)
- What was your favorite part of the Bible story?
- Today we learned that our wrong choices hurt our friendship with God. How does God help us when we make a wrong choice? (*He forgives us. He loves us. He sent Jesus for us.*)
- What is something you learned about God today?
- What can you tell your friends and families about this week?

Our Big Deal is, "Hooray, God Forgives Me"

Hooray (both palms out, make large circles with both arms in front of body)

God forgives me (two thumbs pointing to chest)

We make wrong choices and that hurts our relationship with God. But- Hooray! God loves us so much He sent His Son, Jesus, to forgive us! We can pray and ask God to forgive us today, and He will say yes!"

Prepare kids to talk with their family about what they learned today.

- Pass out coloring pages for kids to take home.
- As family members arrive to pick up their kid, greet them and tell them one thing you noticed about their kid that day or something you talked to each kid about remembering this week.
- If there is time to chat with the family, ask how you can pray for them this week.
- Say bye to the kids and call them by name.
