Armor of God- Put on all the armor God gives you so you can stand strong when things get tough. With God's help, you can stay strong and do what's right no matter what happens. Eph 6:13

Bible- **Mar 23-** Acts 5:17-42 We fight evil with the truth.

Read: Ephesians 6:10-12, 14; Acts 5:17-42

In This Passage: Paul talks about the spiritual battle we're fighting against evil and tells us to put on God's armor. This includes the belt of truth. In Acts, Peter and John put on the belt of truth when they spread the truth about Jesus despite being arrested and beaten.

Bible Point: We fight evil with truth.

Memory Verse: "Therefore, put on every piece of God's armor so you will be able to resist the enemy in the time of evil. Then after the battle you will still be standing firm" (Ephesians 6:13).

Dig Deeper

You'll Be Teaching: We fight evil with truth. In a world that's increasingly devoid of absolute truth, kids need the belt of truth more than ever! They may hear "God isn't real," "Heaven isn't real," or "Whatever is true for you is just true for you." Teach kids to put on the belt of truth to fight against these lies.

Think About: What do you know is true about God?

Dig In to Prayer

Ask God to help your kids stand firm in the truth without being mean or aggressive about their faith.

Quick Tip

You'll find that most Dig In activities are followed by questions. While you may be tempted to skip these for the sake of time, don't! These questions help kids make discoveries about their experiences, which will then stay with them much longer than if you simply tell them the connections. Help kids discover truth with the questions provided.
