God Made Me 1 year olds - 4 year olds

Leader Notes

Bible Passage: God Created People- Genesis 1-2

Bottom Line: God made me and He know me so well.

Leader Context: We are known because God made us. We see this in the story of God making Adam and Eve in Genesis 1-2. When kids are struggling with feeling worthless or unimportant, we get to point them to Jesus and help them know that they are all created by God. Every single kid in your group is important to Him.

THE WIN FOR SUNDAY GROUPS: Give kids a first look at The Bible, Jesus, and our need for a Savior by embracing their physical needs or engaging their interests. Use The Code when necessary to help redirect kids and build relationships.

Social

Games and Music (10 minutes)

What You Need: Instruction Page, Game Sets, Roku Game Instructions

What You Do:

- Play worship songs and other songs available on Roku during the Social Game or while kids are playing.
- Using the supplies and game instruction page, choose one game to play with the kids today.
- As you are playing, use this as a time to call each kid by name and learn their names well.

Say: That was a fun game to get us ready to watch our Bible video. Let's sit and listen to our story today."

Bible Story Video (10 minutes)

Say This!

We have learned something very important today that is a Big Deal! Do you remember what our Big Deal is? Repeat after me! (include the hand motions)

God (point up)

Knows Me (Hands overlaid on chest)

Inside (Press on chest)

And Out (Hands out to shoulder level, palms facing up)

Great job! God knows you inside and out because God made you. I'm so glad God made you. God loves you so much He sent His Son, Jesus, so you can love God and know Him. That is amazing. Let's pray and thank God for making us so special.

"God, thank You for making us so special and for knowing everything about us! Help us know You even better and love You! Amen."

Videos

WOW, God Made Me! (20 minutes)**What You Need:** Wow Printable (1 per kid), assortment of stickers, crayons, stamps

What You Do:

- Give each kid a Wow printable.
- Spread the stickers, stamps, and crayons out on the table.
- Encourage them to find items of things they like or love and stick it in the "O" of their paper.
- They can use their crayons to add family and a picture of themselves.

Say "Can anyone read the word on this paper? It says WOW. Can you read it with me? WOW! Now I want you to take a minute to share your picture with the group and tell them what you put on your paper.

WOW! All the people in our pictures were made by God and so are we. WOW! God knows us inside and out because God made us. He knows everything about us. He knows our names. He knows the things that make us happy or sad. God knows everything about us. Take your picture home today and share what you learned with someone at your house."

Say:

- Who remembers what our Super Clue was? (A clock) And what does a clock help us remember? (God made me inside and out.)
- What was your favorite part of the Bible story?
- God made people- like Adam and Eve- just like He made you and me. What are some other people God made and what can you celebrate about them?
- What is something you learned about God today?
- What can you tell your friends and families about this week?

Let's say our Big Deal together again.

God (point up)

Knows Me (Hands overlaid on chest)

Inside (Press on chest)

And Out (Hands out to shoulder level, palms facing up)

God made you and He knows you- just like He made the first people. God sees you, hears you, and He loves you so much."

Prepare kids to talk with their family about what they learned today.

- Pass out coloring pages for kids to take home.
- As family members arrive to pick up their kid, greet them and tell them one thing you noticed about their kid that day or something you talked to each kid about remembering this week.
- If there is time to chat with the family, ask how you can pray for them this week.
- Say bye to the kids and call them by name.
