God Knows Me Inside and Out Leader Weekly Devotion

Bible Passage: Jesus Met a Samaritan Woman - John 4:1-42

Bottom Line: God knows my story and loves me, no matter what.

Leader Context: We're wrapping up Inside and Out with the story of Jesus and the Samaritan woman at the well in John 4. Jesus knew everything about her and He still loved her- just like us. We get to help kids see that Jesus loves them, no matter what. Kids often worry about who will love them when they mess up. The truth is: God knows our story.

From beginning to end. Even though we mess up and don't always follow Him, He still loves us and wants a relationship with us.

THE WIN FOR SUNDAY GROUPS: Give kids a first look at The Bible, Jesus, and our need for a Savior by embracing their physical needs or engaging their interests. Use The Code when necessary to help redirect kids and build relationships.

Read- John 4:1-44

Highlight: John 4:23-24

Jesus knew everything about the woman at the well, and it didn't stop His amazing and extravagant love for her. Jesus knows our stories- everything about us- and He loves us no matter what. We get to share this unconditional, forever love with the kids in our ministry.

Reflect- What truth about God speaks to you the most right now?

- God knows everything about me and loves me anyway.
- God will never give up on me.
- There is no one that is beyond God's love and forgiveness.

Pray: Jesus thank You that You know and understand me. You graciously love me and help me to follow You. May my mind and heart always be in awe of Your mercy and may I share it and show it to others.

Prepare: When is a time that you felt convicted about sin and then turned to God and felt His forgiveness? Share your story with your small group of kids and leadership team.

Kids need to know they are known and loved. As you consider ways to connect with kids, take a few minutes and check out this video. Pick 1 or 2 of these things to try out the next time you are with your small group. Tell your campus leader how it worked. We want to celebrate with you.
