IN DISCIPLESHIP

September 2, 2026- Disciples know God's voice.

Bible- 1 Samuel 3 God Speaks to Samuel

Disciples know God and show Him to others.

Read: 1 Samuel 3

Highlight: 1 Samuel 3:11

Reflect: Samuel is a young boy who lives in the Tabernacle. One night, he wakes up to someone calling his name. He thinks it's Eli, the priest, but it's not. The third time Samuel hears his name, Eli realizes it's God. Samuel listens to God's message and passes it along. God speaks, so we listen for him. Disciples are set apart by knowing God's voice, following His ways, and helping others see Him through their words and actions.

- Have you ever felt like God was speaking to you?
- How did you respond?

Pray: God, thank You for speaking to us through Your Word and trusted teaching. We see you working around us and praise You for all You do to draw us to You. God, we want to listen to you, even if you have bad news. We invite you now to show us if there are things you want to change about our lives. Show us what we're doing wrong, and show us what you want us to do instead. Amen.

Connect: God speaks. Kids have busier schedules than ever. Without a break in their activities, it can be hard for kids to have room to listen for God. Use this lesson to encourage kids to pause for at least a few minutes each day, allowing space for God to speak.
