God Knows Me Inside and Out Leader Weekly Devotion

Leader Notes

Bible Passage: God Created People- Genesis 1-2

Bottom Line: God made me and He know me so well.

Leader Context: We are known because God made us. We see this in the story of God making Adam and Eve in Genesis 1-2. When kids are struggling with feeling worthless or unimportant, we get to point them to Jesus and help them know that they are all created by God. Every single kid in your group is important to Him.

THE WIN FOR SUNDAY GROUPS: Give kids a first look at The Bible, Jesus, and our need for a Savior by embracing their physical needs or engaging their interests. Use The Code when necessary to help redirect kids and build relationships.

Study

Read- Genesis 1-2

Highlight: Genesis 1:26-27

We are known because God made us. This week, we get to help kids see that they are created special, wonderful, and with great attention to detail.

Reflect- How can you celebrate and appreciate God's creation this week?

- Thank God for the gifts and attributes He's given me.
- Share with someone else the Christ-like qualities I see in them.
- Spend time in nature enjoying God's creation and presence.

Pray: Creator God, thank You for loving me and making me in Your image. This week, help me to find joy in being known by You.

Prepare: God made you and knows you. What is God teaching you about being known that you can share with others this week?
