IN DISCIPLESHIP

September 9, 2026- Disciples share God's truth.

Bible- Mark 4:1-20 Parable of the Farmer and the Seeds

Disciples know God and show Him to others.

Read: Mark 4: 1-20

Highlight: Mark 4: 20

Reflect: Jesus told the Parable of the Sower to explain that people respond to God's Word in different ways. Some hearts are hard, distracted, shallow, or crowded by worries and desires, while others receive God's Word and allow it to grow and produce lasting fruit. The condition of our hearts determines whether God's truth takes root and transforms our lives.

- Which type of soil best describes my heart right now, and what might be preventing God's Word from taking deeper root?
- What practical step can I take this week to cultivate a heart that is receptive to God's Word and produces spiritual fruit?

Pray: God, thank You for speaking to us through Your Word and trusted teaching. Your Word is true and useful to each and everyone of us. Help us not to take this for granted. Help our words, attitude and actions beam with signs that You are working in our lives and we are depending on You. Help us lead little ones to see the same in me and each other.
