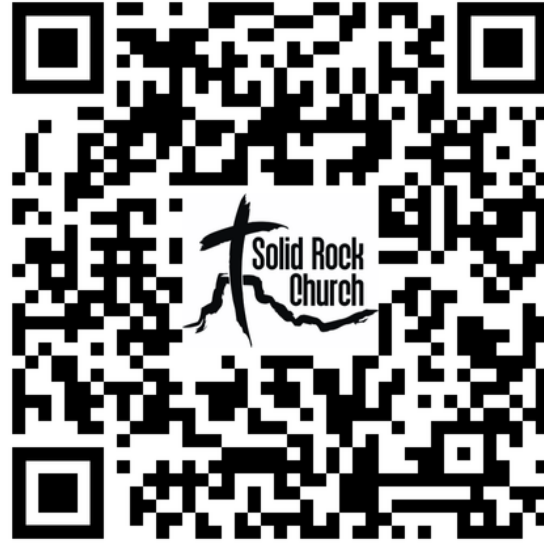


## How Do I Become a Counselor?
