Access requires intervention.



Our *continual access to God* is only possible because of *the eternal work of Christ*.



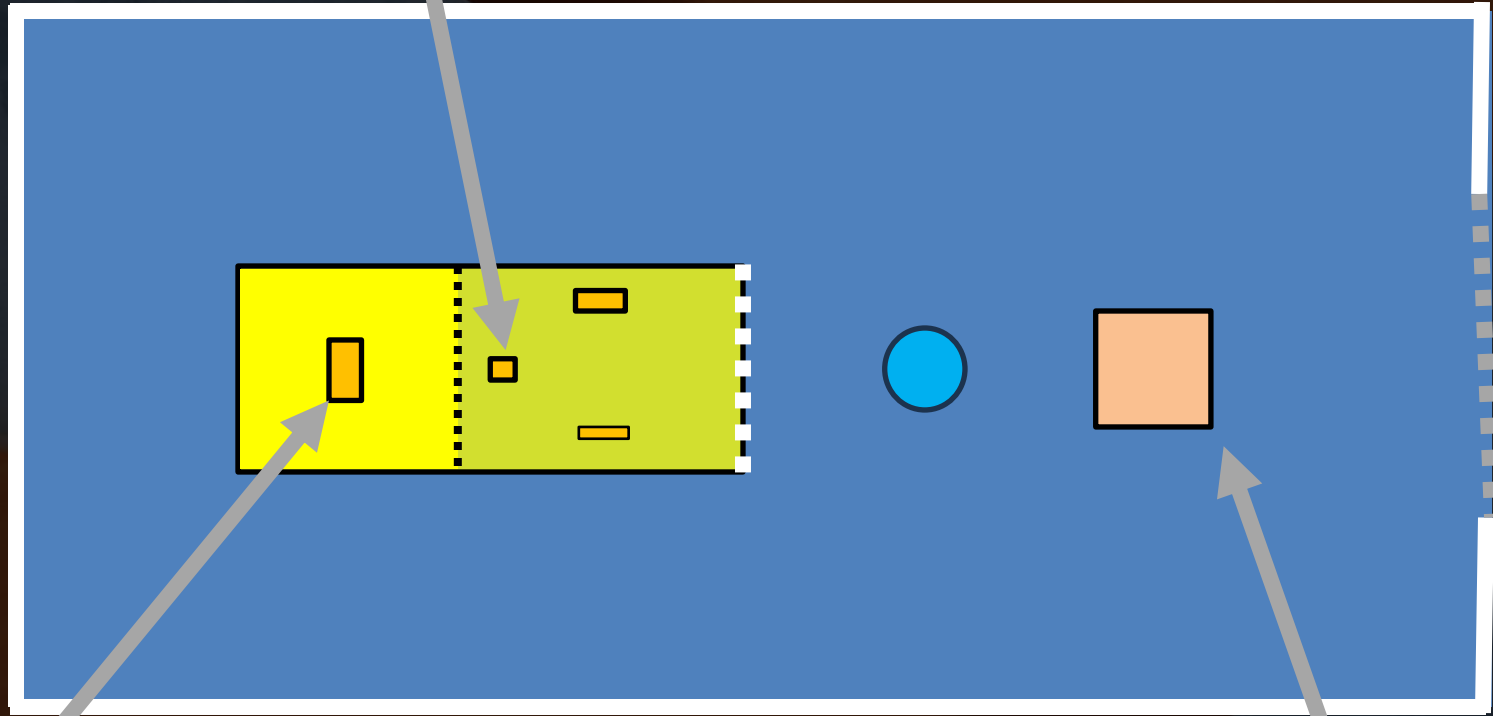

Principle

continual prayer.

The Bronze Basin

Principle

You must be clean from any and all sinful defilement to come into the presence of God.

Key Point #3

Jesus' death provides the eternal cleansing required so that we can be in the presence of God.

The Holy Anointing Oil

Principle

It is God's anointing
that gives holiness.

The Census Offering

Exodus 30:11-16

Principle

You count what you value
and you own.

Key Point #5

You are God's possession.
