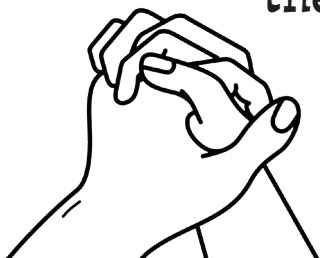


When Jesus held a daughter's hand, something amazing happened. What things can you do with your hands during worship?

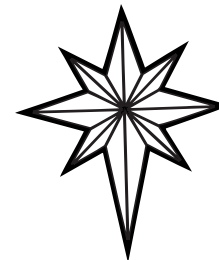
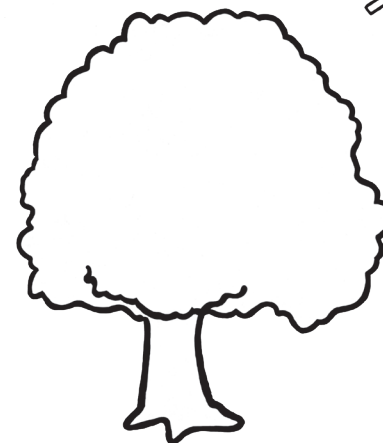

Take a look at these daughters. Can you find the two that are a match?

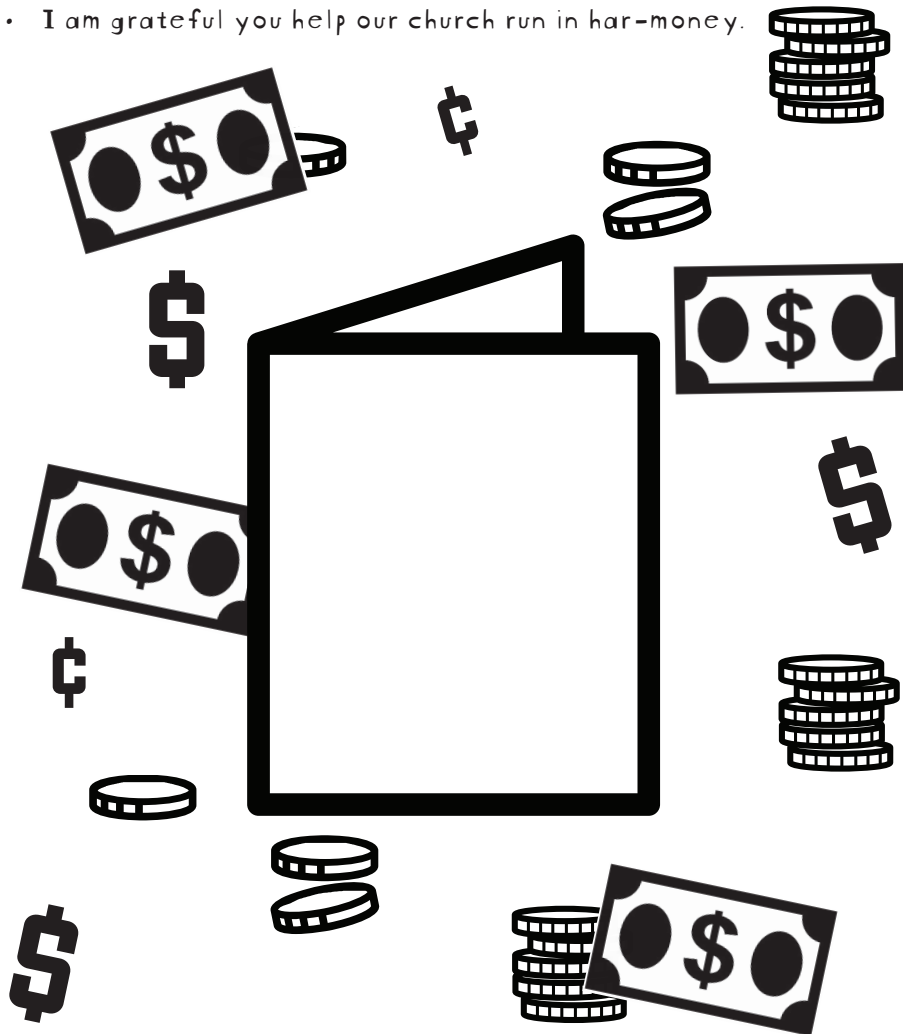


A Glance at Finances

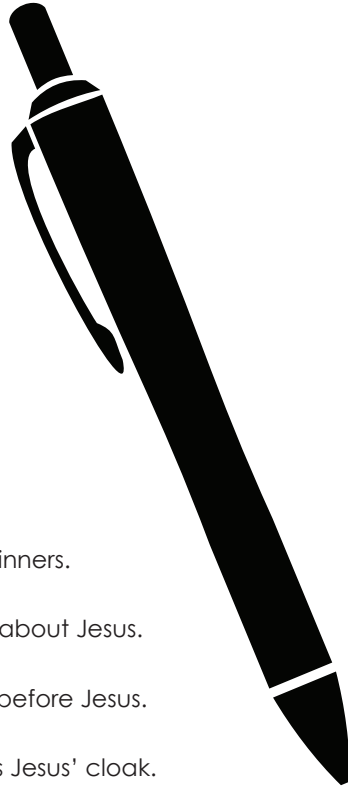

- ___ The crowd laughs at Jesus.
- ___ Jesus takes the girl by the hand.
- ___ Jesus calls Matthew as a disciple.
- ___ Jesus tells the crowd to go away.
- ___ Jesus follows the father to his house.
- ___ The woman is healed of the bleeding.
- ___ Jesus eats dinner with tax collectors and sinners.
- ___ The Pharisees ask the disciples a question about Jesus.
- ___ A father whose daughter just died kneels before Jesus.
- ___ A woman with longtime bleeding touches Jesus' cloak.
- ___ Jesus says, Take heart, daughter; your faith has made you well."
- ___ Jesus says, "For I have come to call not the righteous but sinners."
- ___ Flute players and the crowd make a commotion at the father's house.



You'll find this story of the woman who was healed in the Gospel of Mark with a more dramatic response from Jesus. Read Mark 5:30-34 and notice what is different.

And the Report Spread

During Bible times, news could travel fast, but not in the same ways we get news today. Word of mouth was the main method.
