Color each symbol of the Holy Spirit.

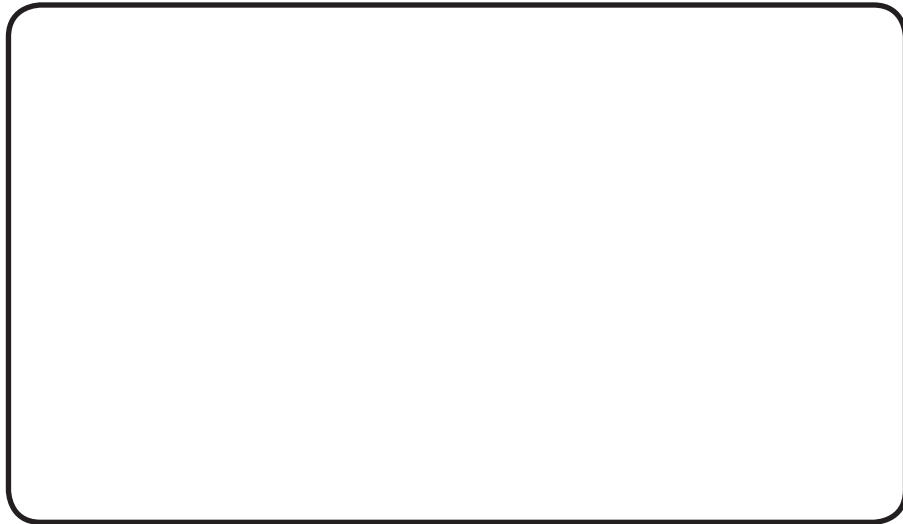


With Us, for Us

The Holy Spirit is a way for God to be with us always. Look around your worship space. What do you see that reminds you that God is with us? Draw or write about it here.



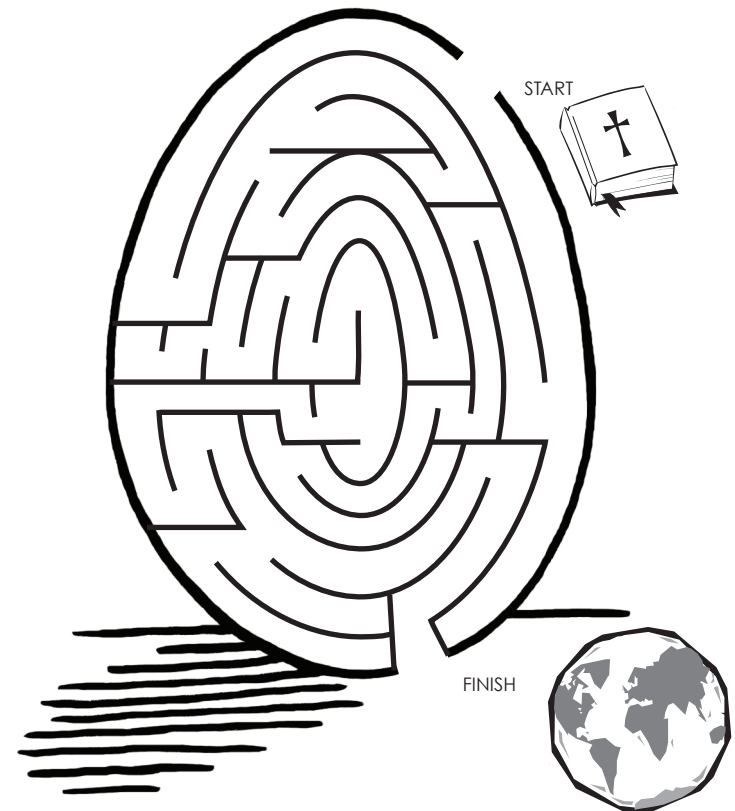

you get stuck.

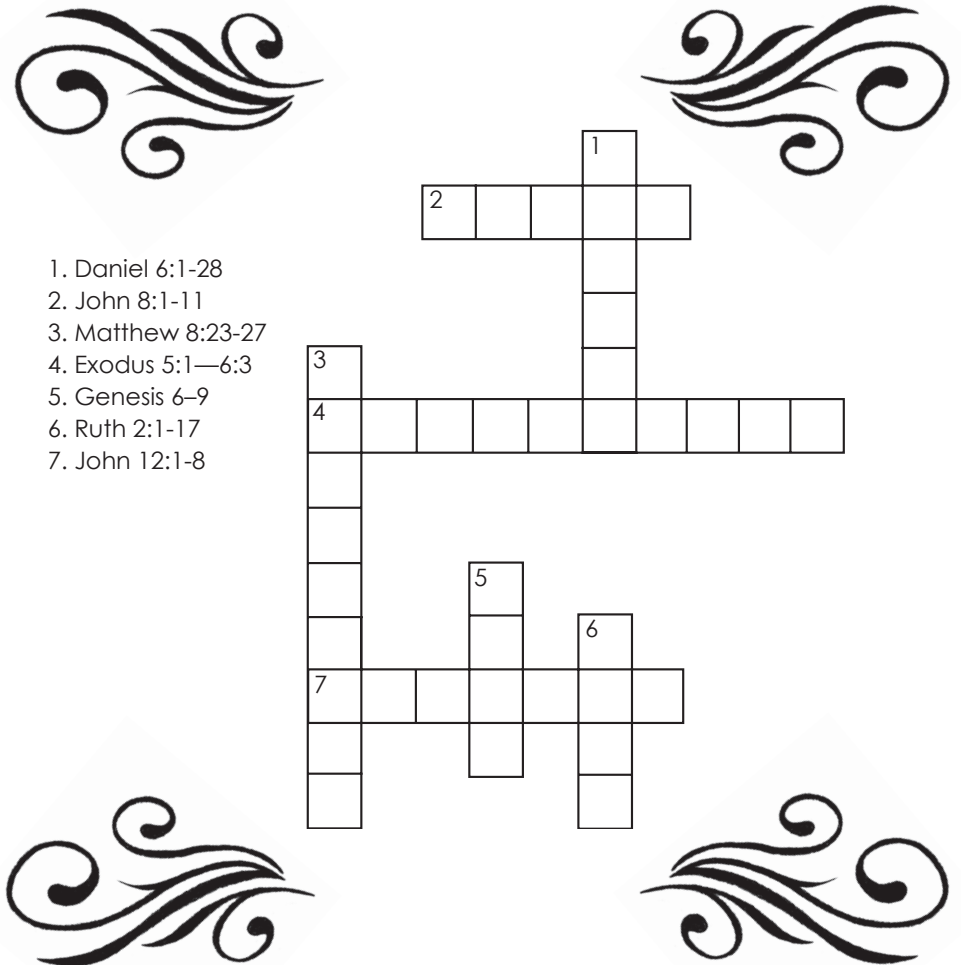
You have heard it said...
