

Life Group Lesson Outline

Life Group Sunday: The Requirements of One Anothering

Date: September 13th, 2026

Icebreaker (10-15 minutes)

Purpose: Encourage fellowship and set a comfortable tone.

Example Questions:

- What is your high and low for the week?
 - What is something that you are looking forward to?
 - Describe a memorable experience of being included and being left out
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Lesson / Discussion (30-40 minutes)

1. Opening Scripture Reading: The 59 One Anothers of the New Testament (see PDF)

2. Question 1 = Pastor Sam's first point that to obey the "One Anothers," you have to belong to the church. What struck you or stood out to you about the relationship between obeying Jesus and belonging to the church?

3. Question 2 = Pastor Sam's second point was that "One Anothering" will require you to get close enough to others in the church that you could get hurt. What are reasons you, personally, find yourself reluctant at times to get involved with or close to others in the church?

4. Question 3 = Pastor Sam's third point was that in order to "One Another" well, you have to experience being "One Anothered" by Jesus. What are ways you have seen, experienced, and felt Jesus fulfilling one or more of the "One Anothers" in your life?

5. Reflection / Prayer

Prayer Requests (10-30 minutes)

- Invite group members to share prayer needs. It would be good for the Leader to start this sharing time.
 - Close with prayer, praying for each request. (if they are comfortable, have each person pray for the person next to them and if anyone is not comfortable have someone fill in for them)
