EXPECTANT *Stories of Legends & Legacies of Faith*

Faith vs. Fear : In Numbers 13:30, Caleb confidently declares, “We should go up and take possession of the land, for we can certainly do it.” Yet, the other spies doubted. What are some areas in your life where you struggle between faith and fear? How can you adopt an “expectant faith” like Caleb?

God’s Timing and Waiting : Caleb had to wait 45 years before receiving the land God had promised him. How do you typically respond to seasons of waiting? What lessons can we learn from Caleb’s patience and unwavering trust in God’s promises?

Stewardship and Obedience : The sermon emphasizes that stewardship is not just about finances, but about trusting God with what He has entrusted to us. What are some practical ways you can steward your time, talents, and resources in a way that honors God?

Choosing the High Ground : Caleb didn’t ask for an easy inheritance—he requested the hill country, the most difficult land to conquer. What is a “high ground” challenge in your life right now that requires you to step out in faith? How can you trust God to help you overcome it?

Overcoming Doubt and Encouraging Others : The ten spies spread fear among the Israelites, leading to disobedience and delay in receiving God’s promise. How can we guard against spreading fear and instead be people who encourage others to trust in God’s faithfulness?

Prayer Prompt:

Lord, we thank You for the story of Caleb and his unwavering trust in Your promises. Help us to develop an expectant faith that moves us to obedience, even when the path seems uncertain. Give us patience in seasons of waiting and courage to step into the high ground You have set before us. Show us how to be good stewards of all that You have entrusted to us, so that we may honor You with our lives. Strengthen our hearts to trust in Your faithfulness, and help us to encourage others to do the same. In Jesus’ name, Amen.
