Lent: I Am The Light of the World

What Does It Mean to Follow the Light?

Jesus says that whoever follows Him will never walk in darkness. What do you think it truly means to “follow” Jesus beyond casual belief? What does surrender look like in everyday life?

Recognizing Spiritual Blindness

The Pharisees had overwhelming evidence but still rejected Jesus. What are some ways people today (including ourselves) can miss or resist truth even when it’s right in front of us?

Light vs. Darkness in Our Lives

The sermon describes Jesus as the light that overcomes falsehood, sin, sorrow, and death. Which areas of “darkness” do you see most present in your life right now, and how can Jesus bring light into those areas?

Power vs. Humble Service

The religious leaders were driven by power and appearance, while Jesus calls us to deny ourselves and serve. Where do you see the tension between seeking personal gain and living a life of humble service?

Shining Your Light to Others

Jesus calls us the light of the world in Matthew 5. What are some practical ways you can “let your light shine” in your home, workplace, or community this week?

Lord Jesus, You are the Light of the world, and we thank You for driving out the darkness in our lives. Help us to fully surrender and follow You, walking in Your truth, wisdom, and grace each day. Search our hearts, reveal anything that keeps us from shining Your light, and lead us in repentance and renewal.
