Church in the Round : Behold the Lamb of God

Knowing Your Place

John the Baptist clearly understood who he was—and who he wasn't. How does John's humility challenge the way we view our own importance, influence, or calling? Where in your life do you need to better recognize God's authority over you?

The Power of a Humble Leader

John was strong, influential, and bold—yet deeply humble. Why is humility such a powerful (and often missing) trait in leadership today? What does it look like to lead as an “under-shepherd” in your everyday life (home, work, church)?

Behold the Lamb

John's declaration connected Jesus to the entire story of Scripture—from Abraham to Passover. Question: What does it personally mean to you that Jesus is the “Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world”? How does that truth impact your view of sin, forgiveness, and grace?

Pointing People to Jesus

John's mission was simple: point others to Jesus—and people followed. Who is someone in your life that you feel called to point toward Jesus right now? What has been holding you back from doing that?

Don't Wait to Be Obedient

The sermon challenges us not to wait for the “perfect moment” (or building) to live on mission. In what ways might you be waiting for better circumstances before stepping out in obedience? What is one practical step you can take this week to live out your faith more intentionally? Who is someone that you need to invite to join you and or your family at church this Easter weekend?

Prayer Prompt

Lord, help me to walk in humility like John the Baptist, recognizing that my life is meant to point others to You. Give me boldness to share Jesus, the Lamb of God, with those around me, and remove any fear or hesitation that holds me back. Show me who You are calling me to reach, and give me the courage to be obedient today. Amen.
