The Lies We Believe – Week 3: Just Follow Your Heart

When Feelings and Truth Collide

Can you think of a time when what “felt right” conflicted with what you knew was right? How did you respond, and what did that reveal about your trust in God?

The Cost of Self-Led Living

The sermon highlights how following our hearts can lead to brokenness (relationships, finances, habits). What are some real-life consequences you’ve seen when people live this way long-term?

Discipline vs. Desire

Hebrews 12:11 talks about discipline producing righteousness and peace. Why do you think we often resist spiritual discipline, even when we know it leads to something better?

An Undivided Heart

Psalm 86 speaks about having an “undivided heart.” What are some things in your life that compete for your devotion to God, and how can you begin to realign your heart toward Him?

Redefining What We Truly Want

The sermon teaches that delighting in the Lord changes our desires. How have you seen your own desires shift (or not shift) as you’ve grown in your faith? What does that process look like?

Prayer Prompt

Lord, search our hearts and reveal anything in us that is not aligned with Your truth, even when it’s uncomfortable to see. Help us not to follow our own understanding, but to trust You fully and choose Your ways over what feels right in the moment. Give us undivided hearts that delight in You, so that our desires reflect Your will and lead us into Your purpose. Amen.
