

# Sunday Sermon Questions • 4/5/2026

## *Easter : I AM the Resurrection and the Life*

### **What Do You Believe About Jesus?**

Jesus asked Martha, "Do you believe this?" (John 11:26).

If Jesus asked you that same question today, how would you answer—and why?  
What shapes your belief (or unbelief) about who Jesus is?

### **More Than a Good Teacher**

Jesus didn't just teach truth—He claimed to be God (John 8:58).

Why do you think some people are comfortable seeing Jesus as a good teacher but not as God? What are the implications if Jesus really is who He says He is?

### **The One Way**

Jesus said, "I am the way, the truth, and the life" (John 14:6).

Do you personally wrestle with the idea that Jesus is the only way to the Father? How can we hold to this truth while still showing love and humility to others? Does knowing this truth create a sense of urgency in your heart to share the gospel message of Jesus with those you know and love?

### **Recognizing Brokenness**

The gospel begins with understanding sin and brokenness.

Where do you most clearly see brokenness in your own life or in the world around you?  
Why is it important to recognize our need before we can fully receive the gospel?

### **When Evidence Isn't Enough**

Even after seeing Lazarus raised, some people still rejected Jesus.

Why do you think people can witness powerful things and still choose not to believe?  
What does this reveal about the role of the heart versus just evidence?

### **Surrender or Control?**

The sermon highlights that there is no middle ground—only surrender or rejection.

In what areas of your life do you find it hardest to fully surrender to Jesus?  
Why do you think we are willing to trust Jesus with where we will spend eternity but not with our everyday decisions?

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### **Life in the Midst of Death**

Jesus declares, "I am the resurrection and the life."

What does it practically mean for you that Jesus has power over both life and death?  
How should this truth impact the way you face fear, loss, or uncertainty?

### **Faith Beyond Circumstances**

Martha believed in Jesus even before seeing Lazarus raised.

When has your faith been tested by difficult circumstances?

What would it look like for your faith to be rooted in who Jesus is, not in what He does?

### **Living Like It's Easter**

The sermon said that for believers, every day should feel like Easter.

What would it actually look like for you to live daily in light of the resurrection?  
What habits or mindset shifts might help you live with that kind of hope and joy?

### **Who Are You Pointing to Jesus?**

The message began with the challenge to invite and point others to Jesus.

Who is one person in your life that needs to hear the gospel right now?

What is one simple step you can take this week to point them toward Jesus?

### **Prayer Prompt**

Jesus, thank You for being the resurrection and the life, and for giving us hope that goes beyond sin and death. Help me to truly believe—not just with my words, but with a surrendered heart that trusts You in every area of my life. Forgive me for the times I've held on to control instead of fully following You. Strengthen my faith and use me to point others to You this week. Amen.
