The Lies We Believe – Week 10: My Worship Doesn't Matter

Worship as a Weapon Against Pride

The sermon teaches that worship helps us shift our focus away from ourselves and onto God. How have you seen pride affect your relationship with God, and how can intentional worship help cultivate humility in your life?

What Is Holding Back Your Worship?

The message challenged the lie, "My worship doesn't matter." What are some reasons people may hold back during worship, and what does wholehearted worship reveal about our view of God?

Casting Your Cares on God

Peter instructs believers to cast all their anxieties on God because He cares for them. What worries or burdens are you most tempted to carry on your own, and what practical steps can help you surrender them to God?

Standing Firm in the Fight

The sermon reminds us that we have a real enemy who seeks to devour us. What are some subtle ways the enemy tries to distract, discourage, or isolate believers, and how can we remain spiritually alert and prepared?

Flourishing Through Godly Leadership

The message suggested that those under our care often reflect the health of our own spiritual lives. Whether in your family, workplace, church, or friendships, what areas of leadership has God entrusted to you, and how can humility, worship, and dependence on God help others flourish?

What is one specific action you will take this week to reject the lie that "my worship doesn't matter" and intentionally draw closer to God?
