Psalm 23

“The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not want”

What does it mean to you personally to see God as your shepherd? In what areas of your life do you need to trust Him more fully?

“He makes me lie down in green pastures”

How does God offer you rest and peace in a busy or chaotic world? Are there ways you're resisting His rest?

“Your rod and your staff, they comfort me”

How do God's discipline and protection bring comfort, even when it's difficult?

“You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies”

What does this verse teach us about God's provision and protection, even in the face of adversity?

Reflecting on Psalm 23

How does Psalm 23 shape your understanding of God's character? Which verse stands out to you most today, and why?

Prayer Prompt:

Take a moment to thank God for being your Shepherd. Ask Him to help you trust His guidance, especially when the path ahead feels uncertain. Invite Him to lead you beside still waters and restore your soul. Surrender any fears or anxieties you're carrying, and rest in the promise that His goodness and mercy are following you today and always. Amen.
