We are Epic Life: Irresistible Community

More Than the Message

Paul says, "We were delighted to share with you not only the gospel of God but our lives as well." What is the difference between simply sharing the gospel with someone and actually sharing your life with them? What might sharing your life look like practically with the people God has already placed around you?

Who Made Room for You?

Think about the people who have influenced your relationship with Jesus. Who made room in their life for you, invested in you, encouraged you, or helped you encounter Jesus? How could you honor the investment they made in you by intentionally making room for someone else?

People, Not Projects

The sermon reminds us that "the people God has placed in our lives are not projects to be solved or fixed; they are people to be loved." How can viewing someone as a "project" change the way we interact with them? What does it look like to genuinely love and invest in someone even if we never see the spiritual outcome we hope for?

Known, Encouraged & Challenged

Hebrews 10:23–25 calls believers to encourage one another and spur one another toward love and good deeds. Do you currently have people in your life who truly know you, pray with you, encourage you, and challenge you to become more like Jesus? What makes that level of honesty and vulnerability difficult, and what becomes possible when we allow ourselves to be truly known?

The Cost of Community

The sermon says, "Community will always cost you something. It will cost you time, convenience, and at times, even comfort. But isolation will cost you far more." Which of those costs is most likely to keep you from pursuing deeper biblical community? What is one intentional step you could take to prioritize community instead of waiting for it to happen?

Prayer Prompt

Lord, thank You for creating us to live in community and for the people You have placed in our lives to encourage us, challenge us, and help us grow closer to You. Give us the courage to make room for others, to share not only the hope of the gospel but our lives as well, and to love people without expecting anything in return. Help us pursue biblical community intentionally and become the kind of people who make Your love irresistible to the world around us. Amen.
