2 Timothy 3:16-17 | The Inerrancy of Scripture | Week 1 (January 1-11)

16 All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, 17 that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work.

John 3:16-17 | The Gospel in a Nutshell | Week 2 (January 12-18)

16 "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. 17 For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him.

Proverbs 3:5-6 | The Christian Posture | Week 3 (January 19-25)

5 Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. 6 In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths.

Galatians 2:20 | Crucified with Christ Jesus! | Week 4 (January 26-February 1)

I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

John 14:6 | Jesus Christ as the Only Way | Week 5 (February 2-8)

Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.

Romans 3:23 | All Have Sinned | Week 6 (February 9-15)

For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,

Romans 6:23 | The Wages of Sin | Week 7 (February 16-22)

For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Isaiah 53:5 | By His Wounds | Week 8 (February 23-March 1)

But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on him, and by his wounds we are healed.

Romans 5:8 | True Love | Week 9 (March 2-8)

But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

Colossians 2:13-14 | Nailed to the Cross | Week 10 (March 9-15)

When you were dead in your sins and in the uncircumcision of your flesh, God made you alive with Christ. He forgave us all our sins, having canceled the charge of our legal indebtedness, which stood against us and condemned us; he has taken it away, nailing it to the cross.

Romans 10:9-10 | To be Saved | Week 11 (March 9-15)

If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved.

1 John 1:9 | Confess Your Sins | Week 12 (March 16-22)

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.

2 Corinthians 5:17 | A New Creation! | Week 13 (March 23-29)

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!

Verses about Trials and Suffering

Philippians 1:29 | Suffering is a Gift | Week 14 (March 30-April 5)

For it has been granted to you on behalf of Christ not only to believe in him, but also to suffer for him,

Proverbs 18:10 | The Lord Jesus is a Strong Tower | Week 15 (April 6-12)

The name of the Lord is a fortified tower; the righteous run to it and are safe.

1 Peter 1:6-7 | Proof of Your Faith | Week 16 (April 13-19)

In all this you greatly rejoice, though now for a little while you may have had to suffer grief in all kinds of trials. These have come so that the proven genuineness of your faith—of greater worth than gold, which perishes even though refined by fire—may result in praise, glory and honor when Jesus Christ is revealed.

James 1:2-3 | Consider it Joy! | Week 17 (April 20-26)

Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds, because you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance.

Romans 8:31 | Who Can be Against Us? | Week 18 (April 27-May 3)

What, then, shall we say in response to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us?

Verses about Fear

Psalms 56:3 | Fear and Trust | Week 19 (May 4-10)

When I am afraid, I put my trust in you.

2 Timothy 1:7 | No Spirit of Fear | Week 20 (May 11-17)

For the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power, love and self-discipline.

Philippians 4:6-7 | Do Not be Anxious | Week 21 (May 18-24)

Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

Psalm 46:10-11 | Be Still and Know | Week 22 (May 25-31)

He says, “Be still, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth.” The Lord Almighty is with us; the God of Jacob is our fortress.

Verses about God’s Word

Isaiah 55:8-9 | Higher Ways | Week 23 (June 1-7)

For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways,” declares the Lord. “As the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts.

Hebrews 4:12 | Sharper than a Sword | Week 24 (June 8-14)

For the word of God is alive and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.

Psalm 1:1-3 | Be a Tree | Week 25 (June 15-21)

Blessed is the one who does not walk in step with the wicked or stand in the way that sinners take or sit in the company of mockers, but whose delight is in the law of the Lord, and who meditates on his law day and night. That person is like a tree planted by streams of water, which yields its fruit in season and whose leaf does not wither— whatever they do prospers.

John 1:14 | The Word is God! | Week 26 (June 22-28)

The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.

Verses about Faith

Hebrews 11:1 | Definition of Faith | Week 27 (June 29-July 5)

Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see.

Hebrews 11:6 | Pleasing God | Week 28 (July 6-12)

And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him.

Romans 10:17 | Faith Comes by Hearing | Week 29 (July 13-19)

Consequently, faith comes from hearing the message, and the message is heard through the word about Christ.

Ephesians 2:8-9 | Saved by Grace through Faith | Week 30 (July 20-26)

For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God— not by works, so that no one can boast.

John 20:29 | Believe without Seeing | Week 31 (July 27-August 2)

Then Jesus told him, “Because you have seen me, you have believed; blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed.”

Verses about Mercy & Forgiveness

Psalm 139:23-24 | Search My Heart | Week 32 (August 3-9)

Search me, God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts. See if there is any offensive way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.

Lamentations 3:22-23 | New Mercies Every Morning | Week 33 (August 10-16)

Because of the Lord’s great love we are not consumed, for his compassions never fail. They are new every morning; great is your faithfulness.

Psalm 103:8-10 | What our Sins Deserve | Week 34 (August 17-23)

The Lord is compassionate and gracious, slow to anger, abounding in love. He will not always accuse, nor will he harbor his anger forever; he does not treat us as our sins deserve or repay us according to our iniquities.

Titus 3:5 | Because of His Mercy! | Week 35 (August 24-30)

He saved us, not because of righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy. He saved us through the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit,

Verses about Praising God

Psalm 103:1-2 | Glorify God! | Week 36 (August 31-September 6)

Praise the Lord, my soul; all my inmost being, praise his holy name. Praise the Lord, my soul, and forget not all his benefits.

Psalm 118:24 | This is the Day ! | Week 37 (September 7-13)

The Lord has done it this very day; let us rejoice today and be glad.

Psalm 100 | The Whole Psalm! | Week 38 (September 14-20)

Shout for joy to the Lord, all the earth. Worship the Lord with gladness; come before him with joyful songs. Know that the Lord is God. It is he who made us, and we are his; we are his people, the sheep of his pasture. Enter his gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise; give thanks to him and praise his name. For the Lord is good and his love endures forever; his faithfulness continues through all generations.

1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 | Rejoice Always | Week 39 (September 21-27)

Rejoice always, pray continually, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.

Verses about Worship

Colossians 3:17 | Living a Life of Thanks | Week 40 (September 28-October 4)

And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him.

Psalm 63:1 | Thirst for God | Week 41 (October 5-11)

You, God, are my God, earnestly I seek you; I thirst for you, my whole being longs for you, in a dry and parched land where there is no water.

John 4:24 | Spirit and Truth | Week 42 (October 12-18)

God is spirit, and his worshipers must worship in the Spirit and in truth.”

Romans 12:1-2 | Living Sacrifice | Week 43 (October 19-25)

Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship. Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will.

“You are worthy, our Lord and God, to receive glory and honor and power, for you created all things, and by your will they were created and have their being.”

Isaiah 40:31 | Wings Like Eagles | Week 45 (November 2-8)

But those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint.

Galatians 5:22-23 | Fruit of the Spirit | Week 46 (November 9-15)

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law.

Luke 1:30-33 | Kingdom Will Never End | Week 51 (December 14-20)
