1. Whatever you do consistently over time...leads to the suddenly moment.
(Moses and the burning bush)

Challenge: Will you commit to consistently pursuing God and his word?

2. Great Commission...**Matt**, 28:18-20 Does that apply to me?
3. Asking God for the **opportunity** to witness. Will He answer that prayer?
4. Asking God for the ability. Anointing to do so...Josh 1:1-8
5. Closing the Deal.
 - It's the Holy Spirit that draws people to himself.
 - Witness as best as you can, and then trust God for the results. (Book Greg Laurie's first convert)
6. Evangelism explosion

EVANGELISM EXPLOSION GOSPEL PRESENTATION

I. Two diagnostic questions

- A. Have you come to the place in your spiritual life where you know for absolutely certain that if you were to die tonight you would go to heaven?
- B. Suppose you were to die today and to stand before God and He were to say to you, "Why should I let you into my heaven?" what would you say?

II. Gospel outline

- A. Grace (Grace is God's love to us, undeserved by us.)
 1. Heaven is a free gift. Romans 6:23
Ephesians 2:8-9
 2. It is not earned or deserved.
- B. Man.

1. Man is a sinner. Romans 3:23
Matthew 5:48
2. He cannot save himself. Proverbs 14:12

C. God

1. God is merciful, therefore He doesn't want to punish us.
2 Peter 3:9
2. God is just, therefore He must punish sin John 3:16

D. Jesus

Jesus paid for our sins and purchased a place in heaven for us which He offers as a gift which may be received by... John 1:1 and 14 :
Isaiah 53:6

E. Faith

1. What it is not—Faith is not a mere intellectual; assent nor temporal faith.
2. What it is—Faith is "trusting in Jesus Christ alone for our salvation."
James 2:19
Revelation 3:20
1 John 5:11-13

III. The commitment.

- A. The qualifying question—"Does this make sense to you?"
- B. The commitment question—"Do you want to receive the gift of eternal life?"
- C. The clarification of commitment
 1. Repent of your sin.
 2. Transfer your trust.
 3. Receive the gift of eternal life through receiving Christ as your Savior and Lord.
- D. The prayer of commitment. Below are two sample prayers of commitment:

1. Dear Lord Jesus, I know that I am a sinner and need your forgiveness. I believe that you died for my sins. I want to turn from my sins and ask you to forgive me of my sins. I now invite you to come into my heart and life. I want to trust you as Savior and follow you as Lord and be the person you want me to be. Thank you for giving me eternal life. Amen.

2. Lord Jesus, I want you to come in and take over my life right now. I am a sinner. I have been trusting in myself and my own good works. But now I place my trust in you. I accept you as my own personal Savior. I believe you died for me. I receive you as Lord and Master of my life. Help me to turn from my sin and follow you. I accept the free gift of eternal life. I am not worthy of it but I thank you for it. Amen.
