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A. To receive the breakthrough that leads to your destiny

1. Recognize that God has been at work in your life.

1 Chronicles 14:2 (NLT)

2. Realize that your breakthrough isn't just for you.
 - i. How we use what God has given us is important (Matt 25)
 - ii. We need to do our best to get and stay healthy.

1 Corinthians 6:19b-20 (NLT)

- iii. We are blessed to be a blessing.
3. Determine to Seek God's will for your Breakthrough.

1 Chronicles 14:8 (NLT)

- i. David knew that he needed a breakthrough...it was a desperate situation.
 - ii. The bigger the problem, the bigger the solution that God will provide for us.

1 Chronicles 14:9-10a (NLT)

- iii. He has a fresh problem and needs a fresh word from God.

1 Chronicles 14:10b (NLT)

B. Why we don't get a breakthrough:

1. We don't *inquire* of God.
2. We don't pray passionate and intense prayers. (Hebrews 5:7)

3. God invites us to come boldly before the throne of God.
4. We don't seek Him until we hear a word from God.

Jeremiah 33:3 (NIV)

1 Chronicles 14:11-12 (NKJV)

5. You have to clean up your act. Don't give the enemy a foot hold.

1 Chronicles 14:13-15 (NKJV)

C. New problems, still require a fresh word from God.

1. Yesterday's methods may not work for today's problems.

1 Chronicles 14:16-17 (NKJV)

2. There are things you haven't even thought of that God wants to do in and through your life.

Zechariah 4:6b (NKJV)
