The Heart of a King – Part 7
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Steps to Freedom

A. Confrontation:

2 Samuel 12:1a (NLT)

1. God is never on the sidelines when His people are caught in sin.
2. He is sending **His word** to you right now.

2 Samuel 12:1b-6 (NLT)

3. David is angry about someone else's sin...but totally misses the references to *his own* sin.

B. Conviction:

1. If you have been dealing with conviction. Today is your day to get free.

2 Samuel 12:7-9 (NLT) .

2. David realizes that he has not only **broken God's law**, but he has **broken God's heart**.

Psalms 51:4a (NLT)

3. The process of repentance includes brokenness.

C . Consequences:

2 Samuel 12:10-12 (NLT)

1. Sin can be forgiven but always has consequences.

Galatians 6:7-8a (NLT)

2. Hidden sin gives it a place in your life.

3. Hidden sin will affect your future and your family.
4. God loves you so much that He will run after you.

D. Confession:

2 Samuel 12:13-14 (NLT)

Conclusions:

- Confrontation:** shows you your sin
- Conviction:** brings brokenness over your sin
- Consequences:** reveal the price of your sin
- Confession:** brings freedom

1. Is openly agreeing with God about our sin instead of hiding, excusing, or blaming.
2. You see your sin the way God sees your sin.
3. Leads to Freedom.
