- Romans 1:16 – *"For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes."*
- 2 Corinthians 5:20 – *"Now then, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were pleading through us: we implore you on Christ's behalf, be reconciled to God."*

We are Christ's representatives on earth, and we must share His message with boldness.

Evangelism is the mission of every believer, and these scriptures provide a strong foundation for sharing the Gospel.
