DAY 1

READ MATTHEW 28:18-20

What sticks out at you from this passage and why?

Select your “My 5”

There are people in your life where God has some divine appointments for you. Some are those who are not Christians. Others may be those who may say they are Christians, but their lifestyle does not match that claim.

Ask God to give you the faces or names of 5 people He wants you to reach out to. These 5 individuals could fit into one of three different categories.

1. Peers: Those friends/acquaintances you believe God is calling you to intentionally pray for, invite to church, and tell about the love of Jesus.
2. Family: Those siblings, parents, or other relatives your heart breaks for.
3. Others: It may be a coach, a neighbor, or maybe even someone you’ve never met in person; yet you feel burdened to pray for his/her salvation.

These 5 individuals will be a pivotal part of your journey in this journal for the next 30 days. Each day’s devotional will have three sections to it. Think **WOW**.

Worship - We will admire/connect with God in a real and personal way.

Outreach - This is where your “My 5” list will come in. Primarily, we will take time to pray for the lost/spiritually struggling individuals we have identified, but there will be other exercises included.

Will - We will consider where and how we need our will and God’s will to collide.

Finish today with a prayer of dedication for the remaining journey you will be going on... “God, I want to go on a journey with You. I give you (name each of your ‘MY 5’). Amen.”

DAY 2

Worship

I will give thanks to you, Lord, with all my heart; I will tell of all your wonderful deeds.

Psalm 9:1 (NIV)

What are the “wonderful deeds” you can thank God for? Take a moment to express those to him in prayer.

Outreach

READ COLOSSIANS 4:2-6

When you look back on “My 5,” what instructions or statements in this passage especially apply to you sharing your faith with them? How do they apply?

Will

God has a plan to reach this world with His message of grace. That plan is you. Write an honest prayer below on your willingness to be a part of His plan to reach those on your “My 5” list.

DAY 3

Worship

Finish this statement 5 different ways: "God, thank you for..."

Outreach

READ MATTHEW 5:14-16.

How do you see this passage of scripture applying to your "My 5"?

Will

When I was in elementary school, we often had an activity called "Show & Tell." The assignment was to bring in a unique personal item to SHOW to the class or to prepare a unique personal story to TELL the class. When it comes to sharing our faith, it is a SHOW & TELL opportunity. We need to show what is unique about our life as a Christian and we need to TELL people our unique story about how we trusted Christ, as well as why we continue to live for Him. **Let's focus today on the SHOW part.**

In what ways are you SHOWing your faith well?

In what ways are you not SHOWing your faith well? What do you need to do about this?

DAY 4

Worship

We all have a mental picture of Jesus. It's likely a bearded white dude in a robe with brown flowing hair, blue eyes, and a beard.

READ REVELATION 1:9-16

John gives us a vision of Jesus that is quite different. Spend time worshipping Jesus in response to this description of Him. Write some thoughts below:

Outreach

You have selected 5 people you want to reach out to. You have 5 fingers on one hand. Take that hand and name each finger after one of your "My 5." As you name that finger, pray for that individual. It may seem strange, but this is a way for you to constantly carry a reminder of your "My 5."

Will

Yesterday we talked about how when it comes to sharing your faith, it is something we SHOW & TELL. **You have evaluated how you are doing at SHOWing your faith. Now let's evaluate the TELL aspect.**

On a scale of 1 to 10, rate your comfort level on bringing Jesus and Christianity into the conversations with your "My 5"?

DAY 5

Worship

Take a walk with God as you walk through this devotional today. Pretend He's walking right beside you (because He is). Make the prayer exercises below a part of your walk and your conversation.

Outreach

Share some "I see..." statements with God concerning your "MY 5." What are some of the dreams you have for their spiritual journey?

Examples:

God, I see Tim worshipping you with all his heart someday.

God, I see Chris sharing his newfound faith with his parents.

God, I see Kate finding freedom from the shame of her past choices.

Will

As you walk together, have an honest conversation with God about where you are in your journey with Him. Let Him in on any secrets you've been holding back from Him. Make it a fun walk together. Laugh together. Listen to what He may want to say to you.

Journal some thoughts from your walk with God below:

DAY 6

Worship

There are words we will often use in church when we are praising God. There is a chance you've used them, but you never knew what they meant.

HALLELUJAH - Hebrew for *Praise to the Lord*.

HOSANNA - From Hebrew words meaning *Rescue me, please*.

AMEN - Hebrew word meaning *I believe it will be so*.

Worship God in prayer, and use these words as a part of your prayer in a way that would be appropriate to where your heart is right now.

Outreach

READ ROMANS 10:11-15

What sticks out to you in this scripture and why?

How do verses 14-15 apply to you?

PRAY: Name your "My 5" before God. Ask for open doors to share the Good News with them.

Will

Ask God, "Is there anything you want me to know today?" Take some time to be still before the Lord and listen for the gentle whisper to your heart.

What do you think He wants to tell you?

DAY 7

Worship

*Sing to the Lord a new song;
Sing to the Lord, all the earth.
Sing to the Lord, praise his name;
Proclaim his salvation day after day.*

Psalm 96:1-2 (NIV)

Take some time to worship God through song today. Play some worship music on your phone, Spotify, etc. and sing along. Sing on your own. Show Him gratitude as you praise him through song.

Outreach

READ ACTS 22:1-21

This passage of scripture is Paul's testimony of how he entered a relationship with God. What sticks out to you from this story and why?

Pray for a "Damascus Road" experience for your "My 5."

Will

Dawson Trotman, founder of The Navigators (a college campus ministry) once said, "God can do more through one man who is 100% dedicated to him than through 100 only 90% dedicated."

How does this quote strike you? What will it take for you to be 100% dedicated to God?

DAY 8

Worship

List some key people who have played an instrumental part in your faith journey.

Choose one, and call, text, or write a note to him/her expressing your appreciation for the role played in your spiritual journey.

Outreach

It's not an issue of distance, but an issue of darkness.

READ 2 CORINTHIANS 4:1-6

We often will remark that someone is "far from God." The reality is that God is not far from anyone. Instead, the "god of this age" (the devil) has blinded the spiritual eyes of those who have not accepted Christ.

PRAY this simple prayer today for each person in your "MY 5"...

God, lift a veil of darkness from (name of "MY 5")'s eyes so he/she might see your light more clearly. AMEN

Will

A Prayer for Today:

*Lord, make me an instrument of Your peace;
Where there is hatred, let me sow love; Where there is injury, pardon;
Where there is discord, harmony; Where there is error, truth;
Where there is doubt, faith; Where there is despair, hope;
Where there is darkness, light; And where there is sadness, joy.
O Divine Master, Grant that I may not so much seek
To be consoled as to console; To be understood as to understand;

Worship

DAY 10

Worship - *READ PSALM 150 OUT LOUD*

Outreach

We know it's not an issue of distance but of darkness (Day 8), but the truth is that the people on your "My 5" list are at differing spots in their openness to the Gospel and readiness to trust Christ. On a scale of 1 (nowhere near ready) to 10 (ready), how would you rate each of your "My 5" on his/her spiritual journey:

DAY 11

Worship

Combine ideas 1 and 2. Take out a sheet of paper and write it, then take a picture of the note and post it.

Outreach

READ 2 CORINTHIANS 5:11-21

This passage has some great things to say about your role in sharing the message of Christ with those around you. What especially sticks out to you from this passage and why?

Focus your prayer today on your role as “Christ’s ambassador” with the “My 5.” Ask God for open doors to tell them about the powerful transformation Paul speaks of in v. 17 (NIV): *“Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!”*

Will

What is a specific area right now where you feel like your desires are not matching up with God’s desire for you? Be honest.

Finish your time with Him today in prayer by submitting your will to His will.

DAY 12

Worship

Let your worship be lived outside your time with God. Over the next 24 hours, find an intentional way to serve someone. Write below what you did:

Outreach

Pray through your "My 5" by name.

Be an encouragement today to one of your fellow youth group members.

Pick someone who you know is seeking to live in a way that honors God.

Send that person a text prayer, or give him/her a call and pray together.

Will

READ JAMES 4:7-10

This passage challenges us toward multiple action steps. Several action steps are followed by a promised response from God or the Devil. Fill them out.

DAY 13

Worship

Outreach

I once had a missionary friend tell me,

I'll often go and talk at churches in the U.S. about the work I am doing in another country. I will invite them to join in on our work through visiting on a short-term team, supporting our efforts financially, and praying. One time, a man came to me after and said, "Well, I have health restrictions that do not allow me to go. I'm very limited financially, so I can't help financially. I guess all I can do is pray."

I looked at that man and said, "Sir, all you can do is pray? That is like a soldier saying, 'Well, I don't have a knife. I don't have a gun. All I have is this nuclear bomb. I guess I'll use it.'"

Never underestimate the power of prayer over your "My 5" list. Pray today with extra passion and confidence that God is at work in the hearts of these individuals.

Will

READ MATTHEW 22:37-40

Did you catch what Jesus said in verse 40? He basically sums up the entire Bible in two simple Commandments. Love God with every part of your life. Love others who are around you. Boom. Jesus drops the mic and walks off! In the past 24 hours, what is one way you Loved God, and one way you showed love to others?

In the next 24 hours, what is one way you will love God, and one way you will show love to others?

DAY 14

Worship

Draw a picture of Praise to God. Just picture yourself as a little kid drawing a picture to a loving dad to show him how much you love him.

Outreach

Pray for the people on your "My 5" list. Take a specific request for each of them to God today based on the issues you know they are going through. Example: "God, I know Tim often feels discouraged. Bring someone across his path who will encourage him today."

Will

READ MATTHEW 22:37-40 again today

In the past 24 hours, what is one way you loved God, and one way you showed love to others?

In the next 24 hours, what is one way you will love God, and one way you will show love to others?

DAY 15

Worship

*Praise the Lord, for the Lord is good;
sing praise to his name, for that is pleasant.*

Psalm 135:3 (NIV)

Worship God through song today. Play some worship music on your phone, Spotify, etc. and sing along. Sing on your own. Show Him gratitude as you praise Him through song.

Outreach

READ MATTHEW 28:18-20

After reading it, pray it out loud for each of your "MY 5" in the following way.

Jesus, help me go & make a disciple of (INSERT "MY 5" NAME). May ("MY 5" NAME) be baptized in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. Jesus, then teach ("MY 5" NAME) to obey all the commands you gave us. And as I do this, I am sure you are with me always, even to the end of the age. Amen.

Will

To affirm Matthew 28:20, pray this prayer of St. Patrick today.

Christ when I lie down, Christ when I sit down,
Christ when I arise,

DAY 16

Worship

Finish this statement 5 different ways: Jesus, you are my...

Make a commitment to stop and pray multiple times for your MY 5 over the next 24 hours. Use the fingers on your hand as a reminder.

DAY 19

Worship

Finish this statement 5 different ways: God, I praise you because...

Outreach

Pray together with someone else you know is taking the "MY 5" Challenge. Lift up the names of those on your lists together.

Will

READ MATTHEW 5:1-11

These "Blessed are..." statements by Jesus are called the Beatitudes. Beatitude is a Latin word that means "happiness."

Which Beatitude (Blessed are...) especially sticks out to you? (Write it out)

What might this Beatitude look like if you were to live it out in your life?

PRAY and ask God to help you live out the Beatitude you have chosen.

DAY 20

Worship

Outreach

A NOBODY NAMED KIMBALL

Edward Kimball was concerned about one of his young Sunday School students who worked at a shoe store in town. One day Kimball visited him at the store and led him to Christ. Dwight L. Moody eventually became one of the greatest preachers and evangelists of all time.

Moody's international speaking took him to the British Isles. There he preached in a little chapel pastored by Frederic Brotherton Meyer. Moody told the story of his Sunday School teacher who went to every student in his class and led each of them to Christ. That message changed Pastor Meyer's ministry, inspiring him to become an evangelist as well.

Years later, Meyer came to America. While he was speaking in Northfield, MA a young man heard Meyer say, "If you are not willing to give up everything for Christ, are you willing to be made willing?" That remark led J. Wilbur Chapman to respond to God's call on his life.

Chapman went on to become one of the most effective evangelists of his time. A volunteer by the name of Billy Sunday helped set up his crusades and learned how to preach by watching Chapman. Sunday eventually took over Chapman's ministry, becoming one of the most dynamic evangelists of the 20th century, leading thousands to Christ.

Inspired by a 1924 Billy Sunday crusade, a group of Christians in Charlotte, NC dedicated themselves to reaching their city for Christ. The group invited the evangelist Mordecai Ham to hold a series of evangelistic meetings. A lanky 16-year-old sat in the crowd one evening, spellbound by the message of the white-haired preacher. Night after night the teen came and finally went forward to trust Christ. That teenager was Billy Graham.

Billy Graham communicated the gospel to more people than any other person in history (an estimated 2.2 billion). It all started with a Sunday School teacher named Kimball.

Can something like this happen today? Of course! God wants to use you to change the world. Pray for your “My 5” knowing God may just start a chain reaction of changed lives through you.

Will

DAY 23

Worship

What are 5 skills/abilities God has given you that you want to thank Him for?

Outreach

For the Son of Man came to seek and to save what was Lost.

Luke 19:10 (NIV)

PRAYER: Jesus, by your own confession You came to earth to seek out those who don't know You and save them from sin, death, and eternity separated from You. I give You (NAME YOUR "MY 5"). I desperately want each of them to come to understand their need for You. I pray that even today each of them might be able to have a moment where they would see how You are seeking them. Amen.

Will

READ COLOSSIANS 3:15-17 and rewrite it in your own words based on what is currently happening in your life.

DAY 24

Worship

Like Days 5 and 17, take a walk with God as you walk through this devotion-
al today. He's walking right beside you. Make the prayer exercises below a
part of your walk and your conversation.

Outreach

Share some "I see..." statements with God concerning your "MY 5." What are
some of the dreams you have for their spiritual journey?

Examples:

God, I see Tim worshipping you with all his heart someday.

God, I see Chris sharing his newfound faith with his parents.

God, I see Kate finding freedom from the shame of her past choices.

Will

As you walk together, have an honest conversation with God about where
you are in your journey with Him. Let Him in on any secrets you've been

DAY 25

God, you so loved (INSERT "MY 5" NAME) that you gave You one and only Son, that if ("MY 5 NAME) believes in him, he/she will not perish but have eternal life. God, you did not send his Son into the world to condemn ("MY 5" NAME), but to save ("MY 5" NAME) through him. AMEN

DAY 26

Worship

Look back on the worship exercise from Day 8 where you listed people who have had an impact on your spiritual journey. Pick someone different from the last time and call, text, or write a note to him/her expressing your appreciation for the role played in your spiritual journey.

Outreach

A Prayer today for your "MY 5":

Lord, it is so amazing that when we accept Jesus, you somehow make us completely new from the inside out. I am not the same person that I used to be. Since I am the only Bible someone might ever see, fill me with your Holy Spirit so your presence shines through me. My life is a living gospel; let it be true to your holiness and grace. Let my speech and conduct be like Jesus in every way. Oh God of distinctions and revelations, I want to be a showcase of heaven on earth. Even now, come Lord Jesus. Amen

Commit this day to go after God and His will with focus and passion!

DAY 29

Worship

Set up a chair where you are doing your time with God. Picture Jesus sitting in that chair as you walk through the following prayer exercises.

Outreach

Using your hand, explain to Jesus who the “MY 5” are. Tell Him why you selected these 5. Tell Him about any opportunities or experiences that have allowed you to share your faith. Let Him know what your hopes and dreams are for each person. Finally, ask Him to do a move in each person’s life so that he/she may come to know Him.

Will

Talk to Jesus about your school. What are some of the things or areas of your school where you hope to see Him more present? How can He best help you as you seek to have your faith COLLIDE with your classes? What do you think Jesus would want to tell you about your upcoming school year?
